

<u>Rootin' Tootin' II - Red Grouper Shootout</u> Information



2/1/13

- Fishing Day: Wednesday, April 10th has been tentatively selected as the day of the fishing tournament. All boats, in both divisions, will fish on the same day.
 - Tuesday (4/9) Thursday (4/11), Friday (4/12) and Saturday (4/13) will be alternate days based on weather conditions. The fishing day will be confirmed by the Tournament Committee no later than April 8th.
- Location: Gulf waters west of Marco Island, FL
- Entry Divisions:
 - 1. 15-Mile Division
 - All boats must fish in waters no further than 15 nautical miles from either Capri Pass Marker R2 (GPS coordinates N25 58.25 W 81 46.27), or 15 nautical miles from Caxambas Pass Light "C"(GPS coordinates N25 54.28 W81 44.23)
 - Minimum of 2 team members per boat
 - 2. 50-Mile Division
 - All boats must fish in waters no further than 50 nautical miles from Capri Pass Marker R2, or 50 nautical miles from Caxambas Light "C."
 - Minimum of 3 team members per boat
- Boats in the 15-mile division will be required to check in with their single largest (by weight) legal size red grouper at the designated official "weigh-in" station (time and location to be announced)
- Boats in the 50-mile division will be required to check in with their two largest (by weight) legal size red grouper at the designated official "weigh-in" station (time and location to be announced)
- The Team Captain must be a member in good standing of the Marco Sportfishing Club. The Team Captain's boat must be used in the tournament
- The Team Captain is responsible for submitting the Team entry form and all entry fees
 - All entries must be matched with a boat
 - Entry fees must be paid in full for a Team to be entered in the tournament
 - Individual entries with no vessel will not be accepted

• Entry fee: <u>MSC Members</u>: \$50 per angler

Non-Members: \$75 per angler

<u>Captain's Entry Fee Waived!</u>

Entry fees for Captains with <u>2 or more crew members</u> will be waived if completed entry form and full payment is received on or before March 7th, 2013.

The entry fee entitles each angler to:

- 1. Participation in the *Rootin' Tootin' II Red Grouper Shootout* and the opportunity to win prizes/awards
- 2. One admission to the *Rootin' Tootin' II* Awards Banquet on Monday, April 15th
 - spouses/guests require a separate paid admission (see entry form)
- 3. One admission to the *Rootin' Tootin' II* Captain's Meeting: Monday, April 8th (time/location to be announced)
- 4. One *Rootin' Tootin' II Red Grouper Shootout* T-shirt <u>completed entry with full</u> payment must be received on or before March 7th, 2013 to receive a T-shirt.
- Entry deadline: April 1st, 2013. No entries will be accepted after this date
- No refunds after April 4th, 2013
- Complete rules for the tournament, including a listing of prizes/awards by division, will be provided to all Captains prior to the tournament and will be posted on the MSC website. The rules will also be reviewed at the *Rootin' Tootin' II* Captain's Meeting.

Rootin' Tootin' II Red Grouper Shootout Prizes and Awards Summary

- Over \$1,200 in cash awards will be distributed
- The 15-Mile and 50-Mile Divisions will compete for boat awards based on the weight of red grouper caught. Competition will be within divisions...not between divisions.
- No boat or individual is eligible to compete in more than one division. To be eligible to win, red grouper must be presented at the "weigh-in."
- Entrants in all divisions will be eligible to win individual awards for a "Wildcard Fish." An individual can win an award for a 'Wildcard Fish" even if he/she has won a boat award in the 15-mile or 50-mile division. To be eligible to win, "Wildcard Fish" must be presented at the "weigh-in."
- An optional "Captain's Calcutta" will be available in each division. There will be one winner of the Captain's Calcutta in each division. (See entry form and rules for additional information.
- Additional information to be provided when final rules are posted on the MSC website. (expected date: 2/15/13)

Rootin' Tootin' II Red Grouper Shootout Captain's Responsibilities

- 1. Ensure your portion and your Crew members' portion of the entry form is complete.
- 2. Check off the division you will compete in
- 3. Collect the appropriate entry fee and payment for any additional Awards Banquet guests from your Crew members
 - Make sure totals are correct for each Crew member
 - Please include the name of any additional guests for yourself and/or your Crew members
 - If the Captain's entry fee is waived, and the Captain decides to bring a guest to the Awards Banquet, the Captain is responsible for paying for that guest.
- 4. Be sure sizes of shirts for yourself and your Crew members are indicated. Entries received after March 7th will not receive T-shirts!
- 5. Once the entry form has been submitted, any questions, changes, cancellations, etc. to your team must be made by you, the Captain, and not by your Crew members
