

REDFISH REDUX
TOURNAMENT RULES
OCTOBER 17, 2017

Boat and Angler Requirements:

- (1) All boats competing in this tournament must have a 9.9 HP or greater engine.
- (2) All boats must have a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 4 anglers.
- (3) Captains must be MSC members.
- (4) Per MSC rules: "Any MSC member or member guest who has guided/chartered six or more trips in the past twelve months or has ever guided full time (12 or more trips per year) in southwest Florida (past or present) is ineligible to compete or participate in any MSC tournament/event that awards prizes."

Tournament Fishing Boundaries: North to Gordon's Pass and south to West Pass.
Important: Do not enter Everglades National Park.

Fishing Hours: Lines in at 8:00 AM, Lines out at 2:00 PM.

Measuring and Recording Fish Caught: Redfish are to be measured, preferably with a ruler having a 90 degree angle, using the "closed mouth/pinched tail" method. All Redfish are to be recorded on the "Boat Talley Sheet" rounded to the nearest ¼". Total "average inches per boat" is calculated by dividing the total inches per boat by the number of anglers. Digital or print photographs must be submitted with the "Boat Talley Sheet" for all Redfish 24" or greater. "Boat Talley Sheets" and photographs must be submitted to Ron Scriver, e-mail: ronscriver@gmail.com, by 6:00 PM, Tuesday, October 17th.

Awards: The total of all entry fees will constitute the cash prize pool. The dollar amount of each cash prize and the number of prizes will depend on the amount of money collected as entry fees. It is anticipated that there will be 4 individual prizes for longest Redfish and 4 boat prizes for most average inches per boat. The most awards that a single angler can receive are two (1 individual and 1 boat).

The awards picnic will be held on Wednesday, October 18th at 12:00 noon at Sarazan Park. Captains, crew, and spouses/significant others may attend. Food will be provided by MSC, but bring your own drinks.
