## **Offshore Report January 2016** by Tony Saputo

Offshore boundaries have been expanded to give all offshore anglers more flexibility to fish.

Effective January 13, 2016  
North of Marco Island as far as Gordon Pass  
South of Marco Island as far as Cape Sable  
Out to 20 fathoms (120 feet) from shore

Harvest of Red Grouper reopened on January 1, 2016 in Federal waters and remain open in State waters. Bag limit remains at 2 per angler. Minimum size 20inches.

Seasonal closure for Black, Red, Gag, Yellowfin, Scamp and Yellow mouth grouper February 1 -March 31, 2016 beyond 20 fathoms (120 feet).

There is a size limit and closure change pending on Gag Grouper Size 22 – 24 inches. Closure from July 1 – December 2 to June 1 – December 31, 2016.

Gray Trigger fish season opened on January 1 in State and Federal Waters.

Coming up on February 11<sup>th</sup> Captains Choice to the new artificial reefs and dinner. Details will be announced at our general meeting on February 4<sup>th</sup>.

## **Backwater Events January 2016**

The Pompano Pounder event was cancelled due to January's weather. Next month will be the Sheepshead Tournament. Weather will be the best.

### **Important Info On Future MSC Picnics** by Dave Walsh

In order to better plan for future picnics, I am releasing the schedule for the first three months of 2016. This should provide everyone with adequate time to get their money in on time, thus minimizing issues of revising orders with caterers. As a reminder, all reservation forms and money must be in my hands by the deadline (just like the banks); postmarks don't mean a thing. For the November picnic I received almost ten checks the day after the deadline. Because it was the first picnic of the season and there wasn't the normal long lead information available, I waived **FOR ONE TIME ONLY** the \$5 late fee for all those received one day late. There can be no forgiveness in the future because we owe it to our caterers to give them firm numbers. Because of everyone's busy Christmas schedule and our Christmas party extravaganza, there will be no picnic in December.

Multiple reservations and checks can be included in the same envelope; however, **SEPARATE CHECKS ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH EVENT!** There is no limit to the number of attendees on each check; just keep the picnics separate for banking purposes. There will be a \$5 returned check fee if I have to send you back a combined picnic check.

Please note that the date for the February picnic is not the normal third Wednesday of the month. **Because of the February Sheep Head tournament, FeBREWfest XI will be on THURSDAY, February 25<sup>th</sup>.**
