President's Message for September 2020



September Tackle Box

The month of September is upon us, and backwater fishing is starting to improve. The "No-Bait" event from August saw some nice-sized Redfish taken by our anglers. As the weather begins to cool down, we will see an increased opportunity for Spotted Seatrout as well. If the water temperature is high, remember to look for shady areas with deep water and good current, especially during the incoming tide. Not only will the incoming tide bring in baitfish which our ambush predators love, but it brings in cooler water temperatures. Best time to fish is in the morning before the sun gets too high and begins to warm up the shallows.

Offshore fishing for grouper (Gag or Red) has picked-up, although Gags are still harder to find. Permit and Mangrove Snapper can be found wreck fishing both nearshore and out to the Towers. AJs and Yellowtail Snapper can be found at deeper wrecks beyond 40 miles. As always, this time of year, keep a weather-eye out for thunderstorms.

In other news, we have Covid-19... The club conducted a recent survey of our members seeking guidance with how we plan for future events, both fishing and social. Over 25% of the members submitted responses. The complete report is included in this edition. The board reviewed the responses and identified several steps to consider as we move forward this year.

Holding fishing events was widely supported. Therefore, the club will continue to offer both backwater and offshore fishing events. However, we will not be holding social events until we can do so safely. Marco Island recently issued a new city order that limits the number of attendees at any social gathering to just **TEN**. MICA has adopted those guidelines, so that pretty much eliminates any option to hold modified Captains' Meetings or Picnics at Sarazen Park.

Our members also asked that the club research the use of video or audio teleconferencing. We are actively investigating the tools to provide that capability for future membership meetings. The somewhat "encouraging" news is that the current trend with positive tests results for Covid-19 is heading in the right direction. Our "positivity rate" is lowering as are the number of new positive tests results per day. We will keep you informed as we constantly monitor the suggested guidelines.

So, let's talk fishing.

Currently, we are midway through the annual Triple Crown Tournament. In September, we will hold the backwater "Double Dose" event. October brings us to the excitement of two backwater events, the competitive "Two-Angler Redfish" and the always fun redfish team event – "Redfish XV". November will provide another opportunity to catch a "Backwater Slam" (Redfish, Snook and Spotted Seatrout) in the "Turkey Slam" event. Offshore we will hold the annual "Super Grouper and Snapper Tournament" in December. Each month we also have "Kayak" events – the ultimate "social distancing" fishing activity. In November, there will be a "Kayak Fishing Tournament". Check out the "Coming Events" page on our website to find out more about these events.

Speaking of Offshore..., Be sure to check out the new "Offshore Homepage" on our website. Offshore Coordinator, Jim Scarpa has put together a great place to see what the offshore anglers are catching. There are "blog reports" and a photo gallery where the offshore captains share their recent adventures with us all.

For those new anglers, or those that want to improve their skills, be sure to check out the videos we have on our website from "Salt Strong", an online fishing cub. We have access to over 500 videos that cover a multitude of topics, from gear selection to fishing and rigging techniques to fishing spot selection. If you have looked at the list previously, please understand that it is updated almost daily. There are even videos of fishing on Marco Island!

Offshore Update - September 2020

What's Happening Offshore...

If you follow our weekly Offshore Fishing Reports, you will see that Red Grouper are being caught from about 65' and deeper, generally with the larger fish in deeper water and the best fishing occurring on the better tide days and windows – use your solunar activity tables. There have been a lot of undersize Red Grouper caught at all depths so hopefully this is an indication that the fishery is strong for future years. Snapper are being caught on wrecks and ledges, but the predators have been plentiful and hungry – if you want to get them to the boat whole (the filets are bigger this way) I recommend a tight drag and high speed reel, reel as fast as humanly possible and don't stop, flip them into the boat as soon as they reach the surface. If this doesn't work, move to another spot. Permit have been found and caught on many of the near and offshore reefs, wrecks and towers 45' to 70'. We have had reports from several spearfishing trips as well this month. I know what you are going to say...Jim, this is not fishing, it's shooting fish in a barrel (send all hate mail to me directly). All kidding aside, the reason I mention this is that there have been sightings of keeper size Hogfish, Mangrove Snapper and Gag Grouper on ledges in 60' to 80' of water recently – go catch them. With the summer weather pattern upon us, keep your radar operational and satellite weather subscription active to best navigate around the storms and be prepared to run when the storms are headed your way, and detour when they are in your path. Get out there and have some fun...and be safe.

I have included a photo of a couple nice permit caught recently.



Offshore Events...

Offshore Slam – unfortunately we had to cancel this event due to low participation. I suspect the virus restrictions and the time of year played a factor. I am planning to try this again in 2021, but as a year-long event so there is plenty of time to catch your slam and our seasonal residents can participate. Constructive feedback is welcome.

Super Grouper / Snapper – SAVE THE DATES, our next Offshore event will be held in December, the fishing window will be Saturday to Saturday, December 12th to19th. This is the new moon period and is the week with the best solunar activity of the month. Details will be released shortly.

Triple Crown Tournament July Report by Ron Scriver





A handful of anglers set out early Tuesday morning, some leaving at dawn's first light, ready to drop their lines in at sunrise for the No Bait tournament. Victor Ordija was one of those anglers who was out on the water early. Limited light, dark water. and sitting low in the water makes it somewhat difficult to see what's in front of you in a kayak. Well, Victor sure got a surprise when he ran into an alligator in the bay! No harm done, Victor continued on and landed a 29" Black Drum later in the morning. Early on, the fish were not very cooperative, but they started biting later in the morning. All of the kayak anglers reported having BIG fish on their lines, but the really BIG ones all managed to get away or break off. Mike Larsen managed to catch a 24 1/2" redfish. That fish put him into the lead for the 2020 Kayak Challenge in the Redfish category. We are 2/3 of the way through the year and Mike is also in the lead with the largest trout and bass. - ! Tuesday October 13th Staggered "Shotgun Start" at Walker's Coon Key Marina or Jolly Bridge
 - All boats start and leave from Coon Key Marina or Jolly Bridge
 - Check-in opens at 7:15 AM, closes at 8:00 AM.
 - Boats not checked in by 8 AM are disqualified. Official start at 8:00 AM.
 - At the start, 3 boats will leave at one time (by starting number). There will be a 30 second interval between each group of 3 boats
- ! Trailering of boats to a different location after the start is not allowed
- ! MSC North boundaries apply, <u>SOUTH to WEST PASS. BE ADVISED! There is No Tournament Fishing in EVERGLADES NATIONAL PARK, (catch and release only).</u>




10. Indoor Gatherings (Meetings, etc.): Current guidelines in Phase Two Reopening for indoor gatherings are limited to 50% capacity and social distancing with 6 ft separation and wearing masks, if unable to maintain that separation. There are also stringent cleaning and disinfecting requirements. As an example, Marco Island Historical Society informed MSC that they could only allow 40 people to occupy Rose Auditorium to satisfy these guidelines. In addition, they just do not have the staff to perform the thorough cleaning/disinfecting and attendee monitoring. (That means taking temperatures, recording names of attendees etc. for Contact Tracing). Therefore, they decided to close for the rest of 2020. 




