## President's Message for February 2021





The MSC board met on January 11<sup>th</sup> and unanimously endorsed the following 2021 Club Officers: Keith Wohltman, President; John Baker, Vice President and Secretary; and Chris Vines as Treasurer. The full roster of board members and event leaders can be viewed on the club website and at the end of this newsletter.

Winter Fishing Time! The cold fronts are bringing cooler temperatures for both the air and water. Our normally aggressive predator fish are lethargic and seeking warmer and deeper waters. This usually changes our targeted species to those hardy winter visitors – like Pompano and Sheepshead. Redfish and Snook can be found up in the inland rivers, bays, and creeks where they can find water warmed by the sun. Be sure to plan your trips carefully when fishing these shallow waters as a falling tide can leave you high and dry.

Unfortunately, the cold fronts also brought us Red Tide. Discharges from Lake Okeechobee in December brought sufficient nutrients that fed the plant-like algae known as Karenia brevis, whose toxins cause both gastrointestinal and neurological problems when digested by fish. The dead and dying fish can then causes problems for predators that feed on them. What little bait fish we can find die quickly in the live wells on our boats.

Many of us have seen the dead fish clogging up our canals and waterways and witnessed the large flocks of buzzards circling our island. The windborne toxins also affect residents and vacationers alike. The conditions were severe enough that we had to cancel our first backwater fishing event of the year.

Conditions are improving, but until the waters in Lake O can be cleaned sufficiently to remove or limit the blue-green algae that combines with the nitrogen rich effluent in the lake discharge, we are likely to see future Red Tides.

On the bright side, Covid vaccines have been available in extremely limited supplies for our first responders, front-line healthcare workers and those over the age of 65. That "over 65" group contains a huge number of residents and visitors in SWFL at this time of year. Many of us have traded fishing for the vaccine lottery. Securing an appointment seems to be as difficult as landing a 150 lb. Tarpon on light tackle, and almost as stressful. Slowly, members of the club have been

## Offshore Update – February 2021

### What's Happening Offshore...

The Red Grouper bite has been hot of late, get out while they are hungry. We can only hope that the red tide moves on soon before more damage is done nearshore. If you are heading out, do not stop for bait unless you are in clean water and put your livewell(s) on recirculate until you are in clean water. The best fishing will usually occur on the better tide days and windows – use your solunar activity tables. Remember Gag season is be closed, Snapper are being caught on wrecks and ledges, but the predators have been plentiful and hungry so...tight drags and reel real fast! The cobia and permit should be back in a couple months, until then focus on catching your trophy grouper and snapper for the Offshore Slam. Get out there and have some fun...and be safe.

## Offshore Events...

Offshore Slam 2021 – The Offshore Slam is a full calendar year tournament so there is plenty of time to catch your Slam of Grouper, Snapper, Permit, and Cobia and win the trophy and some \$\$\$. We also have an award for the boat captain responsible for the most Offshore Slam fish entries. This tournament will be the Offshore version of the highly successful Triple Crown tournament the Inshore guys enjoy. The deadline to enter is June 30, 2021, but you cannot enter a fish caught before you enter, so sign up now before you catch that monster fish and wish you were entered!

Super Grouper / Snapper April 2021 – We are planning the spring tournament for April, with the fishing window from Friday April 9 through Saturday April 17 (yes we added an extra day – Friday April 9 is a very good day on the solunar chart so we threw it in as a bonus).

## Offshore Slam 2021

Fishing Dates: January 1 thru December 31, 2021

Entry Fee: \$25 for MSC Anglers

Prizes: Based on number of anglers participating, maximum one prize per angler

- Total combined length of the largest fish of each Offshore Slam species entered by the angler.
- Angler must catch and enter one fish of each species to qualify to win.
- All fish entered must be caught by the angler entering the fish without assistance.
- Angler may upgrade any fish entered if a larger specimen is caught within the tournament timeframe.
- This is an individual angler tournament and is not tied to a specific captain or boat. The angler may fish on anyone's boat at any time (like the Triple Crown).
- Offshore Slam species Grouper (Red, Gag or Black), Snapper (Mangrove, Yellowtail or Lane), Permit, Cobia.
- In addition to the Offshore Slam prizes, the largest fish of each individual species will be awarded a prize, as will the boat captain with the most entries caught.
- Any fish caught during this event will also qualify for MSC Leaderboard and Fish of the Month entry.

<u>Captains Meeting</u>: Due to the virus, there will be no captains meeting. Please see instructions on Sign-Up Sheet below to submit your Sign-up Sheet and to make payment.

<u>Awards Party</u>: Due to the virus, we are not planning an awards party, if this changes we will let everyone know.

## Rules:

- All anglers must be an active MSC Member.
- MSC "No Guide Rule" applies No fishing with, or on, a guide's boat.
- MSC "Offshore Boundaries" apply South to Lat N 25.10.0, North to Lat N 26.05.5120', must fish within these boundaries and at a depth of 120' or less.
- "Two Line Rule" applies No more than two rods per angler.
- All fish entered must be caught by the angler entering the fish without assistance from any other angler.
- 6. Each fish entered must be photographed individually on a vertical edge tournament ruler, mouth closed and tight against the vertical edge of the ruler (not following the measurement rules may result in a reduction in size if the measurement is not clearly evident). All photos must be emailed to Jim Scarpa at the email address above within 24 hours of being caught.
- 7. Sign-up Sheet and Entry Fee must be received by Jim Scarpa by June 30, 2021 or the angler cannot participate in the tournament. While tournament entry is allowed after fishing begins, no fish may be entered in the tournament that is caught prior to the angler submitting their Sign-up Sheet and Entry Fee.

## Rookery Bay/Stopper's Creek Loop

After a one-day delay due to strong winds, 5 of MSC's finest kayakers ventured out early on Sunday, January 17<sup>th</sup> for the first MSC kayak outing of 2021. The air was a little cool starting out, but as the sun got higher in the sky it was a great day to be on the water. Shell Island was the launch point for this trip, and provided easy access to Rookery Bay. From there, the kayakers made their way to the mouth of Stoppers Creek and followed the winding waterway to its end at the northern end of Rookery Bay. Then it was just a matter of taking Rookery Bay back to the starting point.

This trip kicked off the 2021 Kayak Challenge in which MSC kayakers try to land the largest Redfish, Snook, Trout or Bass during one of the scheduled kayak outings. The kayak angler with the largest of each of those 4 species at the end of the year wins "bragging rights" as well as an MSC Kayak Angler shirt. It didn't take long for the first entry to be caught! Mike Larsen landed a 19" Trout to kick off the 2021 Challenge and put him on the board. Interestingly, Mike landed a 19.5" Trout last year during the January, 2020 kayak outing, and that fish was big enough to hold up all year and grant Mike "bragging rights" for the largest Kayak Trout in 2020. Let's see what happens this year!

This year we are doing the entire process through the Marco Sportfishing Club website.






New Member Applications will be accepted throughout 2021.

# Update from the Editor February 2021

My best wishes to everyone for a Happy New Year 2021. It will be an interesting year as we work ourselves out of the COVID pandemic. The recent weather has been very comfortable and cool, hopefully this will bring the Sheepshead in for our up coming tournament. You will notice that this newsletter is smaller than usual due to event cancelation owing to Red Tide issues and some normal events not even scheduled due to the pandemic. Things will get back to normal soon. Also, the calendars have been replaced with a very brief "Coming Events" page. This was done due to the frequent changes to the dates, times, and locations for the monthly fishing events. Event flyers will still be in the newsletter but the place to get all the most recent and detailed information is the MSC website.

There was a Water Advisory Committee meeting on the 21<sup>st</sup>. The meeting involved a long discussion on the use of sewage effluent water. Currently this water irrigates our golf courses, the landscaped medians along Collier Blvd. and some high-rise properties adjacent to Collier. This "Re-Use" water is very low in dissolved nitrogen and has a minor effect on our waterways due to run off. It was also reported that recent testing continued to show water quality improvement. Our dryer weather is also helping to improve our waters.

Final the much delayed consultants report detailing our water quality challenges and potential solutions is now scheduled to be delivered in May or June.
