#### What's Happening Offshore ...

Thanks to the recent high winds, there has not been a lot of fishing going on offshore, and not many fishing reports either. The Red Grouper bite is still hot, get out while they are hungry. The best fishing will usually occur on the better tide days and windows – use your solunar activity tables. Remember Gag season is be closed, Snapper are being caught on wrecks and ledges, but the predators have been plentiful and hungry so...tight drags and reel real fast! The cobia have been spotted recently and permit should be back soon. Focus on catching your trophy fish for the Offshore Slam. Get out there and have some fun...and be safe.

#### Offshore Events...

**Offshore Slam 2021** – The Offshore Slam is a full calendar year tournament so there is plenty of time to catch your Slam of Grouper, Snapper, Permit, and Cobia and win the trophy and some \$\$\$. We also have an award for the boat captain responsible for the most Offshore Slam fish entries. This tournament will be the Offshore version of the highly successful Triple Crown tournament the Inshore guys enjoy. # Offshore Slam 2021

### Fishing Dates: January 1 thru December 31, 2021

#### Entry Fee: \$25 for MSC Anglers

#### Prizes: Based on number of anglers participating, maximum one prize per angler

- Total combined length of the largest fish of each Offshore Slam species entered by the angler.
- Angler must catch and enter one fish of each species to qualify to win.
- All fish entered must be caught by the angler entering the fish without assistance.
- Angler may upgrade any fish entered if a larger specimen is caught within the tournament timeframe.
- This is an individual angler tournament and is not tied to a specific captain or boat. The angler may fish on anyone's boat at any time (like the Triple Crown).
- Offshore Slam species Grouper (Red, Gag or Black), Snapper (Mangrove, Yellowtail or Lane), Permit, Cobia.
- In addition to the Offshore Slam prizes, the largest fish of each individual species will be awarded a prize, as will the boat captain with the most entries caught.
- Any fish caught during this event will also qualify for MSC Leaderboard and Fish of the Month entry.

# <u>Captains Meeting</u>: Due to the virus, there will be no captains meeting. Please see instructions on Sign-Up Sheet below to submit your Sign-up Sheet and to make payment.

# <u>Awards Party</u>: Due to the virus, we are not planning an awards party, if this changes we will let everyone know.

#### <u>Rules</u>:

- 1. All anglers must be an active MSC Member.
- 2. MSC "No Guide Rule" applies No fishing with, or on, a guide's boat.
- MSC "Offshore Boundaries" apply South to Lat N 25.10.0, North to Lat N 26.05.5120', must fish within these boundaries and at a depth of 120' or less.
- 4. "Two Line Rule" applies No more than two rods per angler.
- 5. All fish entered must be caught by the angler entering the fish without assistance from any other angler.
- 6. Each fish entered must be photographed individually on a vertical edge tournament ruler, mouth closed and tight against the vertical edge of the ruler (not following the measurement rules may result in a reduction in size if the measurement is not clearly evident). All photos must be emailed to Jim Scarpa at the email address above within 24 hours of being caught.
- 7. Sign-up Sheet and Entry Fee must be received by Jim Scarpa by June 30, 2021 or the angler cannot participate in the tournament. While tournament entry is allowed after fishing begins, no fish may be entered in the tournament that is caught prior to the angler submitting their Sign-up Sheet and Entry Fee.

#### February Trip to Hell's Gate/Palm Bay

The second MSC kayak trip of the year was to the Hell's Gate/Palm Bay area. This area is accessed by launching at the base of the Goodland Bridge. Once you make your way across Goodland Bay, you go through the "Gate" where you have access to Palm Bay, Lighter Bay and a number of small mangrove islands. I was interested in trying to find out where "Hell's Gate" got its name and did some searching. I found that this area was named "Hell's Gate" a long time ago....long before boaters had GPS units on their boats that made it easy to navigate and find out where you are at any given time. As a result, years ago, when boaters went through "The Gate" they always felt like they would have "a hell of a time" finding their way back! With GPS units and the tracks they leave, that's something I guess we all take for granted now.

# Update from the Editor March 2021



# Hold the Month, Yes, the Whole Month <u>We Want Our Normal Back</u>

Well, it has been a year now and we have followed the rules, upending our normal lives and activities. Our travel plans have all been canceled and we have watched our cities burn while the police were sent home. We have worn masks, avoided friends, happy hours and spent hours on the phone trying to get a vaccine shot. Well Guy's and Gal's I think it is time to move on and return to a life more like normal. By April many of us have had our Vaccine shot and, in many cases, both shots. We are ready to jump back into life. Well maybe not jump, but at least step.

If we want to return to a semblance of a normal life it is going to be up to us to do it. Only through our actions and involvement can we regain normal. We can sit at home on the sidelines and complain all we want, but it is up to each of us. To help us regain normal the Marco Sportfishing Club is having a oneof-a-kind Backwater Event. This Month-long fun event will allow you to fish as many days as you wish in the month of April. You can pick the Days, Tides, the Hours, your Partners, and the Area (within our club boundaries).

For the first time (in my faulty memory) you will also be helping to pick one of the target species. The Fourth fish in our contest will be selected by the majority of those signing up. The first three (Redfish, Snook and Seatrout) are our regulars. But the fourth will be selected from a list of four species on the signup sheet. The fish getting the most votes will become the Wild Card Fish.

The individual prizes will be based on the documented Largest, Second and Third largest fish of each of the four species. Every Man, Women, Child has a chance to win. To prevent someone from running the table there will be a maximum of two prizes to each individual. We all know, the guy that got on Public's Vaccine list for Marco on his first try.

The entrance fee will be \$15 (\$20 for nonmember) and estimated payout will be \$800, and that includes the club's contribution to the pot as well. All the prizes will be individual, with no boat prize, so Captains you can change out your crew as they are available and assuming they signed up. Each angler will need to pay their entrance fee. Sign up will run through the 9<sup>th</sup> of April, no fish can be registered until you have paid. If you leave town on April 26<sup>th</sup> you can still win if your previously registered fish makes the cut.

On April 1<sup>st</sup>, once we received your \$15 check, you can begin submitting Photo's using the Fish of The Month and Leader Board mechanism run by George Wittmann. Catch a bigger fish two days later, send it in. Check online, George will be doing a weekly (for April) update the Contest chart. First Prize for the largest of each species will be \$100 with a second Prize of \$50 and a third Prize of \$25. #### PARKING IN SURROUNDING SWALES IS SUBJECT TO A FINE

The normal fine for parking on a swale within the vicinity of Sarazen Park is \$95, however due to City Covid-19 restrictions the fine has been raised to \$200 with the possibility your vehicle could be towed. There are several parking alternatives if you do not have a beach pass:

- 1) Obtain a Collier County beach pass and park in the Collier County beach parking lot, which is adjacent and east of the MICA lot. The stickers are free to Collier County residents and available at the Marco Island Library. Information including requirements and off-island sites are at: https://www.collierparks.com/collier\_park/beach-parking-information/ You cannot park in the MICA lot with this sticker. Note that in season on good beach days, the Collier County lot could be full by midmorning.
- Pay the fee for parking in the Collier County parking lot of \$8 (correct change required).
- 3) Find a ride from someone who has a MICA beach pass.
- 4) MICA has made it easier for non-members to park at their facilities. The window sticker required for each vehicle has been eliminated, and all you need to do is have one person in the car with a beach pass card. This allows you to do the MICA Swap where a couple with MICA cards hooks up with a nonmember car and switch passengers (or drivers) so that each car has a MICA member with a beach pass. The MICA Threesome is a variant where one of the MICA members rides as a third person in the nonmember car. Suggested swap sites are: the small Publix, San Marco Catholic Church, the former big Publix, or the Jewish Congregation of Marco Island.
