President's Message for April 2021





April 2021 Tackle Box

Spring is here! That usually signals rebirth after a long hard winter, but his year, perhaps it signals the return to normal after a year of dealing with Covid-19.

Marco Sportfishing Club is beginning to return to normal. Our social activities are taking place in-person. Picnics, Captains' meetings, and our general membership meeting returned in March, albeit at a reduced scale. March's general meeting was held at the Marco Island YMCA and a fair number of members attended. It was great to see them all there.

March featured two exciting fishing events in addition to the year-long "MSC Offshore Slam, proudly sponsored by Rose Marina" (Offshore Slam) and our monthly kayak outing. "Baiting Beauties 8" was a huge success with 37 Lady Anglers enjoying a day out fishing and an awards picnic. In addition to the lady anglers, we had 19 Captains and 15 Crew involved in this event. The second event was held just last week, and it was the "Spring Trout Spotacluar". 50 anglers (45 members and 5 guests), on 20 boats, searched for Spotted Seatrout. Our thanks to all who helped make these events so special.

Several volunteers from MSC helped Marine Industries Association of Collier County (MIACC) run their annual "Kids Fishing Clinic at Naples Pier" on March 6^{th} . The event was an opportunity for kids from the ages of 5 - 15 to learn about fishing and practice what they learned with a fishing rod and reel combo which they could take home. The organizers expected 150 kids – and 318 showed up!

Our April general meeting will be held on Tuesday April 6th at the YMCA Airnasium once again. Our featured speaker will be Captain Brandon Acosta and we will hold a raffle for



a charter fishing trip with Capt. Acosta. In addition, his staff from Everglades Bait and Tackle will be on hand to sell items from their store.

April has a boatload of fishing activities planned. In addition to the "Offshore Slam", we will hold the "Spring Super Grouper/Snapper" event. We have added a special backwater event as well. Our "Back to Normal" month-long event focuses on getting our members back to fishing like we did pre-Covid-19. Emphasis is on fishing with your **friends** once again. Our kayak group will head out to the Fakahatchee Strand Preserve State Park in search of bass. Of course, our Fish of the Month and Leaderboard contests also continue during April.

To round out the festivities, Dave and Suzie Walsh will host a "Taste of Italy" picnic on April 21st.



What's Happening Offshore...

The Red Grouper bite is still hot, many limits being reported, especially in 100'+. The Snapper are out there on the wrecks and ledges, spawning should start soon. Cobia are around now and there have been a few early season permit caught on some of the nearshore reefs. The best fishing will usually occur on the better tide days and windows – use your solunar activity tables. Focus on catching your trophy fish for the "MSC Offshore Slam, proudly sponsored by Rose Marina". Get out there and have some fun...and be safe.

Offshore Events...

Offshore Slam 2021 – The Offshore Slam is a full calendar year tournament so there is plenty of time to catch your Slam of Grouper, Snapper, Permit, and Cobia and win the trophy and some \$\$\$. - Total combined length of the largest fish of each Offshore Slam species entered by the angler.
- Angler must catch and enter one fish of each species to qualify to win.
- All fish entered must be caught by the angler entering the fish without assistance.
- Angler may upgrade any fish entered if a larger specimen is caught within the tournament timeframe.
- This is an individual angler tournament and is not tied to a specific captain or boat. The angler may fish on anyone's boat at any time (like the Triple Crown).
- Offshore Slam species Grouper (Red, Gag or Black), Snapper (Mangrove, Yellowtail or Lane), Permit, Cobia.
- In addition to the Offshore Slam prizes, the largest fish of each individual species will be awarded a prize, as will the boat captain with the most entries caught.
- Any fish caught during this event will also qualify for MSC Leaderboard and Fish of the Month entry.

<u>Captains Meeting</u>: Due to the virus, there will be no captains meeting. Please see instructions on Sign-Up Sheet below to submit your Sign-up Sheet and to make payment.

Awards Party: There will be an awards party at Rose Marina in January 2022 (date / time TBA)

Rules:

- 1. All anglers must be an active MSC Member.
- 2. MSC "No Guide Rule" applies No fishing with, or on, a guide's boat.
- 3. MSC "Offshore Boundaries" apply South to Lat N 25.10.0, North to Lat N 26.05.5120', must fish within these boundaries and at a depth of 120' or less.
- 4. "Two Line Rule" applies No more than two rods per angler.
- 5. All fish entered must be caught by the angler entering the fish without assistance from any other angler.
- 6. Each fish entered must be photographed individually on a vertical edge tournament ruler, mouth closed and tight against the vertical edge of the ruler (not following the measurement rules may result in a reduction in size if the measurement is not clearly evident). All entry photos must be emailed to Jim Scarpa at the email address above within 24 hours of being caught, please include the name of the boat captain as well.
- 7. Sign-up Sheet and Entry Fee must be received by Jim Scarpa by June 30, 2021 or the angler cannot participate in the tournament. While tournament entry is allowed after fishing begins, no fish may be entered in the tournament that is caught prior to the angler submitting their Sign-up Sheet and Entry Fee.

Everglades City/Chokoloskee Bay








Naples Kids' Clinic






