Snowbirds are returning to Marco and everyday more of our northern members arrive to join in club and social functions. They are "happy" to be back in paradise. We are glad to have them back.

October proved to be a great month for our club events. We had a fantastic General Meeting with an outstanding speaker, Capt. Steve Dall. Capt. Dall's presentation focused on how to plan your fishing trip to increase your efficiency and to maximize your fishing time on the water.

Our "Triple Crown Tournament" entered its final month with an extremely tight race between a dozen anglers. We look forward to the General Meeting in November to find out who won.

The 12-month long "Offshore Slam" was steaming along until NOAA and the FWC threw us a curve and closed Red Grouper and Lane Snapper seasons. You can still fish for those species, but it is only "catch-and-release" now. Our offshore anglers are trying to catch the remaining species needed to complete their slam.

The month closed out with two major backwater events. The "Redfish Two-Angler" competition faced some tough conditions, but redfish were caught. Be sure to read Ron Linn's report in this edition. Following closely, we held the "Redfish XVI" team event. Forty-two anglers went out to catch Redfish, Snook, and Spotted Seatrout. Points were awarded for all fish and the team with the highest point total were crowned as winners. The "redfish" frensy concluded with the Redfish XVI picnic on October 25th. Be sure to find out who won by reading Ed Vesely's report.

November begins the "Membership Renewal" period. Members are encouraged to renew by credit card. Of course, checks and cash are welcome, and you can pay in person this year at our General Meeting on November 4th. Or you can mail the completed form along with a check. (*legal residency means you will live in one of these towns fulltime, part time, or for a rental period in 2022 unless "grandfathered" by previously meeting this requirement while a member in good standing*).
- 2. You must agree to the waiver, release, and indemnification.

You will find the two payment options for dues payment. We highly recommend using a credit card – it is easy and safe, the club does not get any of your credit card information, but we do get the funds immediately. Click Here to go directly to the credit card payment page.

Follow the link and complete the registration process. Credit Card payment is preferred but sending in a check and printed form will work too. Or you can bring the form and check/Cash to the November 4th meeting at Mackle Park.

Offshore Update – November 2021

What's Happening Offshore...

For those of you keeping score, Red Grouper harvest is now closed in Federal and State waters for the balance of the year, reopening Jan 1, 2022. Gray Triggerfish harvest is also closed in Federal and State waters for the balance of the year and for the seasonal closure in January & February 2022, reopening March 1, 2022. Lane Snapper harvest is closed in Federal waters for the balance of the year, reopening Jan 1, 2022. More to follow I'm sure. Last, but not least, recreational angler Red Snapper will not be opened for the fall, it will however be open for "For-Hire" vessels Oct 15 thru Nov 5 (apparently the recreational anglers are overfishing). Time to change strategies...

The good news...for \$10 you can enter into a lottery for 1 of 200 permits to be issued in 2022 to harvest 1 Goliath Grouper between 20" to 36". If you are one of the "lucky" ones selected, and for an additional \$500, the permit is yours.

The Snapper are out there on the wrecks and ledges at all depths, Permit continue to be found on the nearshore and offshore reefs and towers, good numbers are still being reported. Cobia are starting to show up in greater numbers and we expect them to continue to move through the area when the water temps begin to drop in the early fall. There is discussion of limiting harvest of Cobia in Federal waters, so get yours now before it's too late. Get out there and have some fun...and be safe.

MSC Offshore Slam proudly sponsored by Rose Marina — Thank you to the 26 anglers that have signed up, focus on completing your slam and upgrading fish as the year progresses. The final day of fishing is Dec 31, 2021 and the final day to enter a fish is Jan 1, 2022. Thanks to Rose Marina, the club and the entry fees paid, have ample budget for additional prize money, trophies, swag, and an awards party.

Super Snapper Nearshore Fall 2021 – Given the closure of Red Grouper in Federal waters, the escalating cost of fuel, and recent dive reports of abundant snapper on nearshore reefs / ledges, we have decided to have a Super Snapper Nearshore event (75' maximum depth). The Captains Meeting will be at Crazy Flamingo Friday Dec 3 at 4:00 pm. The fishing window will be Saturday Dec 4 through Sunday Dec 12, 2021. This window includes the new moon and several high solunar activity days. Prizes will be awarded for the top three boats based on the combined length of 3 legal Mangrove or Yellowtail Snapper. In addition, a prize for the largest legal Mangrove or Yellowtail Snapper will be awarded, as well as each of the two wild card fish – Gag Grouper and Tripletail. The event flyer and sign-up sheet are attached. Looking forward to a great turnout and to get some of the smaller boats involved given the 75" max water depth and the fact that legal fish of all 4 species can be readily caught within this depth range.

- MSC "Offshore Boundaries" apply South to Lat N 25.10.0, North to Lat N 26.05.5120', must fish within these boundaries and at a depth of 75' or less.
- ALL Captains must declare their fishing day in advance to Jim.
- "Two Line Rule" applies No more than two rods per angler.
- 7. The fish being entered must be photographed individually on a vertical edge tournament ruler, mouth closed and tight against the vertical edge of the ruler (not following the measurement rules may result in a reduction in size if the measurement is not clearly evident). All photos must be emailed to Jim Scarpa at the email address above on the day caught.

Triple Crown Tournament Report

Marco Sportfishing Club's 2021 Triple Crown Tournament, sponsored by The Compass Group at Morgan Stanley, will complete its four-month run on Sunday, October 31st. Contest submissions must be made by November 3rd, and winners will be announced at the November 4th General Meeting.

The last update posted on the club website was submitted on October 12th, and only the event leader will know the results until the November 4th meeting. Back on October 12th, Ed Brown was in the lead by a very slim 5.5-point lead over Kevin Krygier. David Dodd had the largest Snook, (not in the top 5) - a 40.25 incher, and Jay Jones had the largest Redfish (not in the top 5) - a 29.5 incher.

There are 10 Tarpon on the board. 19 Redfish with a total length of 506 inches, an average of 26.6 inches, are listed, along with 17 Snook totaling 504 inches, an average of 29.6 inches.

With only 10.5 points, or 5.25 inches of Redfish and/or Snook separating 1st and 5th place on October 12th, the final standings can change with one big fish being caught in the last two weeks of the event. Considering that all those who have caught a tarpon could move into the top 5 slots with big catches it is anybody's guess who will win and who will be in the top spots.

The two recent redfish tournaments offered ample of opportunity for a shake-up in the top five and for the special category of largest redfish or snook, not in the top 5.






Update from the Editor November 2021





SUMMARY of PARKING RULES at SARAZEN

MSC picnics are generally held at Sarazen Park (check picnic flyer). Sarazen Park is a private park located at the SE corner of the Collier Blvd. and Swallow Ave. It is controlled by The Marco Island Civic Association (MICA) and parking in the park requires a member's pass. MICA membership is available to owners of improved property on Marco Island or yearly renters. Each adult member is issued a membership/beach pass card.

JOIN MICA to avoid any parking problems. If you live on the beach and don't belong, consider joining for the other benefits MICA provides. Besides use of Residents Beach and Sarazen Park, there are activities such as free concerts, plus discounts at restaurants and other venues.

Car pooling is suggested to provide more spots for fellow MICA members.

PARKING IN SURROUNDING SWALES IS SUBJECT TO A FINE

The normal fine for parking on a swale within the vicinity of Sarazen Park is \$95, however due to City Covid-19 restrictions the fine could be \$200 with the possibility your vehicle could be towed.

If you cannot get a MICA pass because you are a short term renter or have moved off the island there are alternatives:

- If you do not have a pass you can walk in and pay \$5/person (new rule). See below for suggestions on where to park.
- 2) Obtain a Collier County beach parking pass and park in the Collier County beach parking lot, which is adjacent and east of the MICA lot. The stickers are free to Collier County residents and available at the Marco Island Library and other sites throughout the County. You cannot park in the MICA lot with this sticker. Note that in season on good beach days, the Collier County lot could be full by mid-morning. MICA \$5 walk-in fee applies.
- Pay the fee for parking in the Collier County parking lot of \$8 (correct change required).
- Have a MICA member give you a ride into Sarazen. Suggested meeting places are: Publix, San Marco Catholic Church, the former big Publix, or the Jewish Congregation of Marco Island.


