To recap last month's newsletter, **The American Patriot** is a state of the art, long range fishing vessel docked at Rose Marina here on Marco Island. At 135' X 29', the boat specializes in 3, 4, 5 day, all the way up to 10-day fishing adventures!

The Captain will discuss deep water species, jigging, deep water methods, electric reels etc. A 3D video presentation of boat and the adventure will answer most questions, along with the Captain and crew filling in the blanks. 

What's Happening Offshore...

Red Grouper reopens in Federal and State waters and Lane Snapper reopens in Federal waters Jan 1, 2022. Gray Triggerfish harvest remains closed in Federal and State waters until March 1, 2022.

Snapper are out there on the wrecks and ledges at all depths. Cobia are here near structure and around the bait pods, several nice ones have been caught recently. African Pompano are also being caught, seem to be on the smaller side of late, and an assortment of others – AJ's, Lesser AJ's, even picked up a few Almaco Jacks recently. Oh, if you try hard you may even spot a barracuda or two (thousand) on any structure.

Pick a calm day and get out there and have some fun...and be safe.

MSC Offshore Slam 2022, proudly sponsored by Rose Marina – We made a few changes (see below) to make the year-long event more competitive...many thanks to those who provided suggestions. - 2. Added the requirement that all fish entered must be of legal length to minimize handling of non-legal fish
- 3. Modified the "Slam" to add additional eligible species, and to require 1 Grouper, 1 Snapper, and any 2 out of 5 additional included species to complete the "Slam". The additional included species are Permit, Cobia, Kingfish, African Pompano and Amberjack.



Changes from the 2021 Offshore Slam:

- Added Mutton Snapper to the allowable Snapper species.
- Added the requirement that all fish entered must be of legal length to minimize handling of non-legal fish.
- Modified the "Slam" to add additional species and require 1 each of Grouper and Snapper and 2 out of
 5 of the additional included species to achieve the Slam.

Prizes: Based on number of anglers participating, maximum one prize per angler

Total combined length of the largest legal size fish of each Offshore Slam species entered by the angler.
 If an angler catches more than 2 of the 5 optional species the two with the longest length will be counted.

- Angler must catch and enter one Grouper, one Snapper and any 2 of the 5 additional species listed
- All fish entered must be caught by the angler entering the fish without assistance.
- Angler may upgrade any fish entered if a larger specimen is caught within the tournament timeframe.
- This is an individual angler tournament and is not tied to a specific captain or boat. The angler may fish on anyone's boat at any time see "No Guide Rule" below (like the Triple Crown).
- In addition to the Offshore Slam prizes, the largest fish of each individual species will be awarded a prize, as will the boat captain with the most entries caught.
- Any fish caught during this event will also qualify for MSC Leaderboard and Fish of the Month entry.

<u>Awards Party</u>: There will be an awards party at Rose Marina in January 2023 (date / time TBA)

Rules:

- 1. All anglers must be an active MSC Member.
- 2. MSC "No Guide Rule" applies No fishing with, or on, a guide's boat.
- 3. MSC "Offshore Boundaries" apply South to Lat N 25.10.0, North to Lat N 26.05.5120', must fish within these boundaries and at a depth of 120' or less.
- 4. "Two Line Rule" applies No more than two rods per angler.
- 5. All fish entered must be caught by the angler entering the fish without assistance from any other angler with the exception of landing (gaff, net, etc).
- 6. Each fish entered must be photographed individually on a vertical edge tournament ruler, mouth closed and tight against the vertical edge of the ruler (not following the measurement rules may result in a reduction in size if the measurement is not clearly evident). All entry photos must be emailed to Jim Scarpa at the email address above within 24 hours of being caught, please include the name of the boat captain as well.
- 7. Sign-up Sheet and Entry Fee must be received by Jim Scarpa by June 30, 2021 or the angler cannot participate in the tournament. While tournament entry is allowed after fishing begins, no fish may be entered in the tournament that is caught prior to the angler submitting their Sign-up Sheet and Entry Fee.

POLICY Summary

- 3) Ride with a MICA member.
- 4) Have a MICA member ride with you.
- 5) Parking on the swales within a mile of South Beach Access or Sarazen Park is not permitted. The current fine is \$95.

Due to a few weather cancellations the November kayak trip took place too late in the month to make the cutoff for the December newsletter. So, this month's report will cover both our November and December outings!

The November trip was supposed to take place in Rookery Bay, using the Shell Island Road launch, but we ran into technical difficulties.
