Changes from the 2021 Offshore Slam:

- Added Mutton Snapper to the allowable Snapper species.
- Added the requirement that all fish entered must be of legal length to minimize handling of nonlegal fish.
- Modified the "Slam" to add additional species and require 1 each of Grouper and Snapper and 2 out
 of 5 of the additional included species to achieve the Slam.

<u>Prizes</u>: Based on number of anglers participating, maximum one prize per angler

- Total combined length of the largest legal size fish of each Offshore Slam species entered by the angler. If an angler catches more than 2 of the 5 optional species the two with the longest length will be counted.
- Angler must catch and enter one Grouper, one Snapper and any 2 of the 5 additional species listed

- All fish entered must be caught by the angler entering the fish without assistance.
- Angler may upgrade any fish entered if a larger specimen is caught within the tournament timeframe.
- This is an individual angler tournament and is not tied to a specific captain or boat. The angler may fish on anyone's boat at any time see "No Guide Rule" below (like the Triple Crown).
- In addition to the Offshore Slam prizes, the largest fish of each individual species will be awarded a prize, as will the boat captain with the most entries caught.
- Any fish caught during this event will also qualify for MSC Leaderboard and Fish of the Month entry.

<u>Awards Party</u>: There will be an awards party at Rose Marina in January 2023 (date / time TBA)

Rules:

- 8. All anglers must be an active MSC Member.
- 9. MSC "No Guide Rule" applies No fishing with, or on, a guide's boat.
- 10. MSC "Offshore Boundaries" apply South to Lat N 25.10.0, North to Lat N 26.05.5120', must fish within these boundaries and at a depth of 120' or less.
- 11. "Two Line Rule" applies No more than two rods per angler.
- 12. All fish entered must be caught by the angler entering the fish without assistance from any other angler with the exception of landing (gaff, net, etc).
- 13. Each fish entered must be photographed individually on a vertical edge tournament ruler, mouth closed and tight against the vertical edge of the ruler (not following the measurement rules may result in a reduction in size if the measurement is not clearly evident). All entry photos must be emailed to Jim Scarpa at the email address above within 24 hours of being caught, please include the name of the boat captain as well.
- 14. Sign-up Sheet and Entry Fee must be received by Jim Scarpa by June 30, 2021 or the angler cannot participate in the tournament. While tournament entry is allowed after fishing begins, no fish may be entered in the tournament that is caught prior to the angler submitting their Sign-up Sheet and Entry Fee.

POLICY Summary

- Due to scheduling and caterer contracts, picnics will be held rain or shine (except in the event of named storms).
- No refunds will be given for cancellations on the day of the picnic.
- A list of paid attendees will be published several days prior to the picnic so there will be no confusion about who has paid or not paid.
- In order to facilitate the above and allow proper notification to caterers, payment deadline is one week prior to the picnic.
- Payment must be in the hands of the picnic chairman by the deadline, not in the mail (just like the banks, so be aware of holidays).
- The late fee is \$3 per/person.
- Walk-in fee is \$5 (plus \$3 late fee).
- Guests cost more (other fees above also apply).

CURRENT PICNIC PARKING RULES Picnics are held at the MICA Sarazen Park (910 Swallow Ave.) and MICA membership is required. There are several alternatives if you do not qualify for MICA membership:

- Collier County residents can get a Collier County beach sticker and park in the Collier County parking lot, which is adjacent and east of the MICA lot. You cannot park in the MICA lot with this sticker. Be aware that Park Rangers sometimes hassle you, claiming the parking is for the beach only, and will ticket you if you go to the picnic. HINT: Don't make it obvious you're going to picnic (e.g. passing chairs over fence).
- Pay the fee for parking in the Collier County parking lot (\$8).
- 3) Ride with a MICA member.
- 4) Have a MICA member ride with you.
- Parking on the swales within a mile of South Beach Access or Sarazen Park is not permitted. The current fine is \$95.




