#### President's Message for June 2022

# **FWC Redfish Workshop**

# June 8<sup>th</sup>: 6:00 to 8:00 PM Rookery Bay Environmental Learning Center 300 Tower Road

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) is holding a workshop to gather public input on proposed rules for redfish that include nine new management regions and modified recreational bag, vessel, and off-the-water transport limits. The FWC developed these proposed changes using a new management approach to better capture regional differences in the fishery.

## Offshore Update - June 2022

#### What's Happening Offshore...

Still windy...hopefully the summer pattern will bring calmer wind.

2022 ARS (American Red Snapper) season dates have been announced! Summer season opens June 17 and ends July 31. There are also 5 weekends in the fall season – Oct 8-9, 15-16, 22-23, Nov 11-13 and 25-27. Go get em!

Red Grouper are being caught typically in 100-120' of water, continue to get reports of nice catches typically in the deeper water.

Snapper are out there on the wrecks and ledges at all depths and will be spawning June / July. Some Cobia are still around but the migration has passed us until fall. African Pompano & AJ's are around structure. Permit are here, try the wrecks and reefs with higher relief and towers, they usually cannot resist a live crab.

Pick a calm day and get out there and have some fun...and be safe.

- 3. Modified the "Slam" to add additional eligible species, and to require 1 Grouper, 1 Snapper, and any 2 out of 5 additional included species to complete the "Slam". The additional included species are Permit, Cobia, Kingfish, African Pompano and Amberjack.



# April, 2022 MSC Kayak Group Outing Isles of Capri Paddle Park

April's Kayak outing took place at the Isles of Capri Paddle Park on Tuesday 4/26/22. Originally, this was supposed to be a bass fishing trip to the Port of the Islands freshwater canals. But, the Everglades water management division has done some work in the canals recently, resulting in poor fishing conditions for now.

The trip started out on a beautiful morning at 7:45 AM, with 10 kayakers in attendance. It was easiest the best weather day for a kayak trip in at least a year. Highs in the 80's, a good tide with no wind or waves to contend with. The entire trip was over 7 miles including upper and lower Johnson Bay. The scenery was enough to make it a great day on the water even if you're not catching fish, however that was not the case.

Among the species caught were Snook, Redfish, Snapper, and even a Barracuda. With their catches, Ken Robertson and Bob Schneider switched spots on the Kayak leaderboard. Ken recorded a 26 3/4" Snook, despite missing out on a slot sized one earlier in the day. Bob Schneider jumped into the top Redfish spot with what may be a hard to beat 26 3/4" Redfish.

# 2022 MSC Kayak Slam Sponsored by Naples Outfitters May 2, 2022



The second MSC "Kayak Slam" began on a beautiful Monday morning at the Isles of Capri Paddle Park. This event, sponsored by Naples Outfitters, provides kayakers of all skill levels with the opportunity to compete in an enjoyable and fun event. You don't even need to own a kayak to enter this tournament! For those who wanted to enter but didn't have a kayak, Naples Outfitters provided Hobie kayaks with pedal drives, and delivered the boats right to the launch site. It couldn't be any easier!

By random draw, all novice to intermediate kayakers are paired up with experienced kayakers for the day of kayak fishing. However, if spouses want to compete as a team, they may do so, and are exempt from the random draw. This year, Gloria and Ken Robertson bypassed the draw and entered as a team. When the fishing begins, each team sets out in search of a Kayak Slam...a snook, a redfish and a spotted seatrout. The team with the most total inches is the winner!

Since "kayak fishing" was a new experience for some of the anglers, the experienced kayakers spent some time with their teammates giving them a "Kayak 101" introductory lesson. Once they felt ready, the teams made their way out into McIlvane Bay and headed for the mangrove trails, where they hoped to get their slams. Once the teams made it to the mangroves, additional on-site training was needed for some of the newer kayakers, who had to learn, pretty quickly, how to untangle themselves, their kayak and fishing line from the ever-present mangrove branches and trees that seem to be everywhere.



While the weather, fishing conditions and tide cooperated during the day, the fish, unfortunately, did not. The 8 teams of kayakers fished all over McIlvane Bay, Johnson Bay and Rookery Bay, but the redfish weren't biting and neither were the trout. None of the kayak teams were able to record a "kayak slam". Surprisingly, no team completed a mini-slam either (two of the target species). Luckily, 6 of the 8 teams caught a snook, so this tournament ended up being a snook tournament, and instead of a "kayak slam," 6 teams turned in a "kayak micro-slam" (1 of the target species).

At the end of the day, the big winners were the team of Bob Schneider and Mike Lopez. Mike (novice kayaker) landed a 27" snook. That single catch earned his team the winning prize of \$140




