President's Message for August 2022



Summer is in full swing which means it is “Hot, Hot, Hot”. The afternoon thunderstorms are here and so are our little green friends... Green Iguanas. At least one of our members is working hard to keep them from burrowing into the fill behind his seawall. Iguanas prefer that loose drainage material to dig their burrows, but will also dig under sidewalks and near the foundations of homes. Their excavations can damage your property.

The FWC lists Iguanas as an invasive species and states that “like all nonnative reptile species, green iguanas are not protected in Florida except by anti-cruelty law and can be humanely killed on private property with landowner permission.” Landowners can remove the iguanas themselves or contact the City of Marco Island and their contracted “Iguana Trapper” to remove iguanas from their property.

Speaking of “Invasive Species” ... the August 4th general meeting will feature our Collier County Sea Grant Agent, Mike Sipos, who will talk about “Florida’s Invasive Species”. This will be a presentation you won’t want to miss.

Looking back to July, our club continued the year-long “Offshore Slam, proudly sponsored by Rose Marina”, and kicked off a 4-month long backwater event – the eleventh annual “Triple Crown Tournament”, sponsored by The Compass Group at Morgan Stanley.

Several members wasted no time logging fish in the “Triple Crown Tournament” and you can track the standings on the club website. Registration is open until August 31st, and you still have plenty of time to catch your slam! Be sure to read Dave Schott’s report in this edition.

July also saw the annual “Shark Tournament” that culminated with the “Man Bites Shark” picnic. Paul Milici organized and led the event, and John Baker did an excellent job providing both shark and burgers on the grill. Offshore Update – Aug 2022

What's Happening Offshore...

ARS (American Red Snapper) season opened Friday June 17 and closes July 31. We have had many reported limits of ARS in the 160'+ range and some very nice sized fish as well...its seems that the ARS fishery is very healthy and improving year after year. Get out before the season closes. If you miss the summer season, or want to catch more ARS, there are also 5 weekends in the fall season – Oct 8-9, 15-16, 22-23, Nov 11-13 and 25-27. Go get em!

Red Grouper are being caught typically in 100-120' of water, continue to get reports of nice catches typically in the deeper water. Lots of short fish around in shallower water, expect them to start moving closer with the warming water.

Snapper are out there on the wrecks and ledges at all depths. For whatever reasons, the cuda seem to be more cooperative this year and area allowing anglers to land the whole fish most of the time – reel as fast as you can until the fish is in the boat and do not let it linger in the water near the boat or it will be “upgraded”. Some Cobia are still around but the migration has passed us until fall. African Pompano & AJ's are around structure. Permit are here, try the wrecks and reefs with higher relief and towers, they usually cannot resist a live crab.

Pick a calm day and get out there and have some fun...and be safe.

2022 “MAN BITES SHARK” Event

Six boats with 18 anglers headed out into Gullivan Bay on Wednesday, July 13th to kick off MSC’s annual “Man Bites Shark” event. The anglers were greeted by sunny skies, typical Southwest Florida July heat, and a bit of a chop on the water. Once each of the captains anchored on their “secret spot”, out went the chum and the baited hooks. For a couple of boats, the action started almost immediately. For others, it took a little while for the sharks to cooperate or they simply refused to do so. Only eleven sharks were landed, i.e. leader touched and picture taken, and many more were hooked but broke off. Those landed included Blacktips, Atlantic Sharpnose, Hammerheads, and others unidentified sharks.

A picnic was held at Sarazan Park on Friday, July 15th and was attended by twenty four anglers, spouses, and guests. The picnic menu included grilled shark, hamburgers, hot dogs, and all the fixings. A special thanks to John Baker who handled all of the picnic logistics, including preparing and cooking the shark fillets.
