President's Message for September 2022



September already? Wow this year is flying by. Seems like only yesterday we were finishing up the Sheepshead tournament and looking forward to Baiting Beauties 9.

August was a fairly quiet month. Hot days and stormy afternoons made fishing in the 10,000 Islands an adventure. Sweltering heat in the backwaters and always keeping an eye on the weather, but we did have several days with calm

waters offshore. Some decent size fish were caught offshore, and reports of limiting out on Red Grouper east of the towers seem to point toward an improvement in the water quality west of Marco.

Our backwater anglers did venture into the 10,000 Islands in search of Redfish, Sea Trout and Snook in the always challenging "No Bait" event. Both kayakers and boaters competed to catch the largest fish of those three species.

The kayak group also fished in Chokoloskee Bay targeting the same summer species. Read about their adventure in this edition.

We have reached the midway point in the "Triple Crown Tournament" and put the 8th month of our Offshore Slam in the record books. The "Triple Crown Tournament" has seen very few Tarpon registered but three members have caught all three species and now have two months to increase their total points. Registration for the "2022 Triple Crown" closed on August 31st.

Speaking of closing... both the FWC and NOAA Fisheries announced the closure of Red Grouper season on August 30th at 12:01 AM. This means Red Grouper can not be harvested in both state and federal Gulf waters. The closure will be in effect until January 1, 2023.

September 1st is when the new Redfish regulations go into effect. In our "Southwest Management Zone", we can harvest one legal sized Redfish per angler on a boat, up to a bag limit of two fish per boat. Catch and release for Redfish in waters to our north ends on August 31st, and a similar set of regulations take effect in their management zone. Both the reduction in the boat bag limit and ending the catch and release regulations should benefit our Redfish population. The catch and release restrictions for Snook also end on August 31st. Snook season will open on September 1st. Our backwater anglers will look to catch both of those species in the "Snook and a Redfish" event.



Offshore Update - Sept 2022

What's Happening Offshore...

ARS (American Red Snapper) - If you missed the summer season, or want to catch more ARS, there are 5 weekends in the fall season – Oct 8-9, 15-16, 22-23, Nov 11-13 and 25-27. Go get em!

Red Grouper will be closed to recreational anglers and for hire vessels from Aug 30, 2022 through Dec 31, 2022 in state and federal waters. By the time you see this newsletter season will be closed...I hope everyone got their fair share this year. I do not recommend catch and release for these fish during the closed season due to the potentially high mortality rate due to barotrauma, let them be and they will be plentiful when the season re-opens.

Snapper are out there on the reefs, wrecks and ledges at all depths. There have been some nice snapper caught of late with many in shallower water (50-90') near reefs / wrecks. Be aware of predators, reel as fast as you can until the fish is in the boat and do not let it linger in the water near the boat or it will be "upgraded". Some Cobia are still around but the migration has passed us until fall. African Pompano & AJ's are around structure. Permit are here, try the wrecks and reefs with higher relief and towers, they usually cannot resist a live crab.

Pick a calm day and get out there and have some fun...and be safe.
