In case you forgot, we also have the final month of the "Offshore Slam, proudly sponsored by Rose Marina".



Offshore Update – Dec 2022

What's Happening Offshore...

ARS (American Red Snapper) – The last weekend opportunity of the fall season is behind us, I hope everyone got a chance to fish for ARS and enjoyed their catch. For those who did venture out to target ARS, there was a lot of good fishing reported. Next opportunity will be summer 2023.

Red Grouper is closed to recreational anglers and for hire vessels through Dec 31, 2022 in state and federal waters. I do not recommend catch and release for these fish during the closed season due to the potentially high barotrauma mortality rate, let them be and they will be plentiful when the season re-opens.

There have been some nice snapper being caught, including some nice Muttons, with many in shallower water (50-90') near reefs / wrecks and on ledges. Keep an eye on the crab traps nearshore and out to about 65' of water for Tripletail laying under the buoys, they cannot resist a live shrimp freelined or under a small float. Cobia are in the area migrating south and have been seen / caught on several of the nearshore reefs / wrecks and towers, keep a live bait or big jig handy in case one pulls up behind your boat. African Pompano can be found typically near structure and as shallow as 80'. AJ's are around structure as well but season is closed through April 30, 2023. Spanish Mackerel schools are showing up feeding on the bait schools, look for surface activity and working birds to locate them, they are lots of fun on light tackle – don't forget the wire leader! Trolling lures or drifting larger live baits on the outer edges of the Spanish Mackerel schools may find a hungry King too. Permit seem to have left for winter, they will be back in spring.

Pick a calm day and get out there and have some fun...and be safe.



POLICY Summary

- Due to scheduling and caterer contracts, picnics will be held rain or shine (except in the event of named storms).
- 2) No refunds will be given for cancellations on the day of the picnic.
- A list of paid attendees will be published several days prior to the picnic so there will be no confusion about who has paid or not paid.
- 4) In order to facilitate the above and allow proper notification to caterers, payment deadline is one week prior to the picnic.
- 5) Payment must be in the hands of the picnic chairman by the deadline, not in the mail (just like the banks, so be aware of holidays).
- 6) The late fee is \$3 per/person.
- 7) Walk-in fee is \$5 (plus \$3 late fee).
- 8) Guests cost more (other fees above also apply).

CURRENT PICNIC PARKING RULES Picnics are held at the MICA Sarazen Park (910 Swallow Ave.) and MICA membership is required to park. There are several alternatives if you do not qualify for MICA membership:

- Collier County residents can get a Collier County beach sticker and park in the Collier County parking lot, which is adjacent and east of the MICA lot. You cannot park in the MICA lot with this sticker. Be aware that Park Rangers sometimes hassle you, claiming the parking is for the beach only, and will ticket you if you go to the picnic. HINT: Don't make it obvious you're going to picnic (e.g. passing chairs over fence).
- 2) Pay the fee for parking in the Collier County parking lot (\$8).
- 3) Ride with a MICA member.
- 4) Have a MICA member ride with you.
- 5) Parking on the swales within a mile of South Beach Access or Sarazen Park is not permitted. The current fine is \$95. 11/25/2022

MSC Kayak Group Trip November 13, 2022 – The Imperial River

November's trip took the MSC kayakers back to an area that we had not been to for a while...the Imperial River in Bonita Springs. 6 weeks ago, this area was hit hard by Hurricane Ian, and although the beautiful houses lining the river did not appear to have been severely impacted, it was clear that many of the docks and boats along the river were damaged due to the 7-foot storm surge that came roaring up the river. Despite that, the launch and the river itself were clear, and there was quite a bit of boat traffic both at the launch and on the river itself.

In the past, our outings to the Imperial River have produced some of the largest fish caught by the kayak group each year. I am pleased to report that the Imperial River did not disappoint this year, and lived up to its reputation. Not very long after starting out, Dave Schott was casting under one of the docks lining the river and landed a 29.5" Snook. That fish was the largest Snook caught on a kayak trip this year, and moved Dave into the top position in the 2022 Kayak Challenge. Ken Robertson had been in the lead with a 26.5" Snook caught earlier in the year. Dave was enjoying his "spot at the top" for a while, but a little while later we got a message on the radio that Ken had hooked into a big Snook and was trying to land it. He did land it, and it was "over-slot," measuring 35.5". That put Ken back on top of the 2022 Kayak Challenge leaderboard for Snook. With one month left in the challenge, that one looks like it is going to be tough to beat.





Besides those two big snook, the kayak anglers caught a number of other species, including redfish, trout, jacks and even a goliath grouper. We will be going back to the Imperial River again soon!

For our final outing of the year in December, we will be launching from the Jolley Bridge and will be headed up into Unknown Bay. From there, we will loop back to the bridge through Bear Point Cove. This trip has proven to be a popular one with the group in years past, and we are looking forward to another large turnout.

- Wild Card Fish is Barracuda Prize for largest fish and most fish caught (NOTE: there is a size and bag limit in state waters, there is no size or bag limit in Federal waters 9 miles and out). If entering for largest fish, please measure per rule 7 below. If entering for most fish, a photograph of each legal fish individually is sufficient. Be careful handling these fish, their teeth are dangerous.

<u>Captains Meeting</u>: <u>Friday Dec 2 3:00 pm at Crazy Flamingo</u>. If you wish to register in advance, please email signup sheet to Jim Scarpa at the address above and make arrangements with Jim to drop off the entry fee or have it picked up prior to the event.

<u>Rules</u>:

- 1. ALL Captains must be an active MSC Member.
- 2. Captain / Boat may only fish one day, Captain may fish as a crew member with another Captain / Boat.
- 3. MSC "No Guide Rule" applies No fishing with, or on, a guide's boat.
- 4. MSC "Offshore Boundaries" apply South to Lat N 25.10.0, North to Lat N 26.05.5120', must fish within these boundaries and at a depth of 85' or less.
- 5. ALL Captains must declare their fishing day in advance to Jim.
- 6. "Two Line Rule" applies No more than two rods per angler.
- 7. The fish being entered must be photographed individually on a vertical edge tournament ruler, mouth closed and tight against the vertical edge of the ruler (not following the measurement rules may result in a reduction in size if the measurement is not clearly evident). All photos must be emailed to Jim Scarpa at the email address above on the day caught.

The Picnic, run by John Baker, came off without a hitch and finished the event with a good time being enjoyed by all.


So here is a quick event recap.


