Howdy once again!! Time again for the much anticipated monthly newsletter, and in reference to the date of our next General Meeting, "MAY THE 4TH BE WITH YOU." Sorry, but I couldn't help the Star Wars quote!! Now, back to fishing... If you haven't noticed the different monthly Tackle Box fish pictures, I'm trying to use either something relevant to my topic, or just really cool photos - this one is both, and gives me three things to talk to you about. I've been asked several times by new members, as well as those who are still new to the MSC, about how and where to catch certain types of fish, and also if there are any events for our women anglers.

There are many ways to learn about fishing and the local area, from Captains with charters, to neighbors or friends or other MSC members, or on our website https://www.marcosportfishingclub.com. A great place to start there is on the top menu dropdown, look under "Fishing Info", and then under "What's in Your Tackle Box", and also in that same sub-menu, "How Do I Catch These Fish". Many great links exist from catching different species of fish to hooks, knots, rods & reels, and one of our favorites - Salt Strong. https://www.saltstrong.com. There's so much great information to get ideas and learn from. As far as our Club is concerned, we are rolling out something new at the May meeting with a signup list for Captains looking for Crew or vice versa. The intent is to try and get more experienced members out with new folks or members without boats who love to fish. We'll also look into posting something similar to this signup list in future newsletters.

All of our memberships are "FAMILY" oriented, which means that spouses or significant others as well as dependent children are included. Ladies are welcome in ALL our events, and we have many anglers who take advantage of this. Our annual Baiting Beauties Event, held every March, specifically targets Lady Anglers and is run by long time member Cathy Erickson. It's been a great tournament, running for 10 years now, and the next event is set for March 3-10, 2024. Volunteer captains take the anglers out for a day of fishing for multiple species of fish and fun, and there's a picnic event at the end of the week for awards. You can even invite your non-member friends to participate!

Finally, that leads me to this month's picture of our current Treasurer, Donna Deeter. Caught on July 2nd, 2020, her 42.5" Snook is the current documented MSC record Snook caught. Along with a same-day-catch Tarpon, it vaulted her quickly into the lead to win the MSC annual Triple Crown Tournament which runs July 1st - October 31st. Snook seasons per the FWC currently run from March 1st - April 30th, and September 1st - November 30th where you can keep a 28"-33" slot fish in our area. Donna's was caught using a live Threadfin on a 6/0 circle hook, 40 pound monofilament leader, and 30 pound braid, paired on a Shimano Teramar rod and Penn Battle II 6000 spinning reel. The giant Snook was just laying in wait right along the edge of the mangroves in 4 feet of water, and the rest is history. Threadfin, Pilchards, & Greenies caught nearshore either with a 10 foot cast net or a sabiki rig are my favorite live bait! Ladies, get out there and fish!

CAPTAINS, once again please get your **VESSEL SAFETY CHECK** done, and make sure and give anyone you take out on your boat a good SAFETY BRIEFING. Your crew may end up saving your life if something goes drastically wrong!

Offshore Update - May 2023

What's Happening Offshore...

Don't forget...Gag Grouper is closed and will re-open Sept 1 through Nov 10, 2023, AJ will re-open May 1, 2023.

Red Grouper are being caught from 45' on out, with larger fish and higher keeper rates in the 100-120' range. Target your fishing window during times with good current flow and high solunar activity for best bite. Snapper can be caught at all depths (bigger fish usually being in deeper water), including some nice Muttons, near reefs / wrecks and on ledges. Keep an eye on the crab traps nearshore and out to about 65' of water for Tripletail laying under the buoys, they cannot resist a live shrimp free-lined or under a small float. There have been reports of Cobia in the area recently migrating to the north, keep a live bait or big jig handy in case one pulls up behind your boat (they are not the smartest fish in the ocean). African Pompano can be found typically near structure and as shallow as 80' and they usually start schooling up in late spring. AJ's are around structure as well and will re-open for harvest May 1, they are fun to bend a rod if you are looking for a great fight. There has been a lot of bait nearshore so keep an eye out for Bonito and Spanish Mackerel feeding on the bait, look for surface activity and working birds to locate them, they are lots of fun on light tackle – don't forget the wire leader for the Mackerel! Trolling lures or drifting larger live baits on the outer edges of the Spanish Mackerel schools may find a hungry King too. Last, but not least, Permit are back…look for them on any wrecks / reefs with high relief and around the towers – they are lots of fun to catch and cannot resist a live crab.

Pick a calm day and get out there and have some fun...and be safe.




