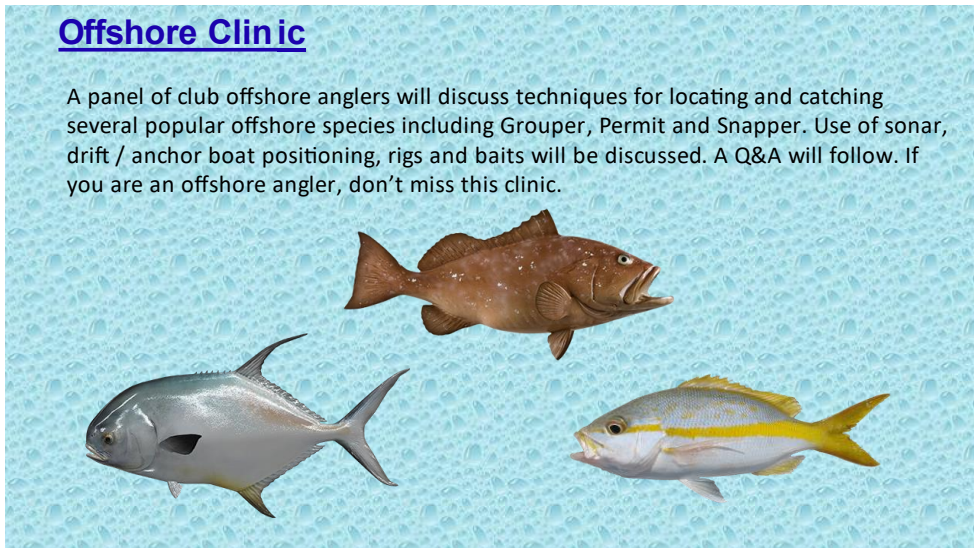

A panel of club offshore anglers will discuss techniques for locating and catching several popular offshore species including Grouper, Permit and Snapper. Use of sonar, drift / anchor boat positioning, rigs and baits will be discussed. A Q&A will follow. If you are an offshore angler, don't miss this clinic.



Offshore Update – July 2023

What's Happening Offshore..

Don't forget...Gag Grouper is closed and will re-open Sept 1 through Nov 10, 2023. Amberjack is closed and will re-open Aug 1, 2023.

Red Grouper will close starting July 21, 2023 through the end of the calendar year...get them while you can!

American Red Snapper summer season for recreational anglers opened June 16 and will close July 31, 2023. Fall season will be every Friday-Sunday in the months of October and November 2023. "For Hire" vessels may harvest from June 1 through August 24, 2023.

American Red Snapper (ARS) can be caught starting at 130', best fishing typically begins at 160'. Reports on American Red Snapper are mixed with some finding fish in known spots and others not finding fish in spots that were known to be productive in the past. Once you find fish, limits come fast. My personal experience so far this season is that some spots that have been very productive in prior years are not holding any fish currently...American Reds or other species (see photo below of a nice ARS recently caught). Red Grouper are being caught from 45' on out, with larger fish and higher keeper rates in the 100-120' range. Target your fishing window during times with good current flow and high solunar activity for best bite...and prior to the closure July 21. Snapper can be caught at all depths (bigger fish usually being in deeper water) near reefs / wrecks and on ledges. Cobia have migrated through the area and will be back in the fall, there may be a few hanging around so keep a jig or live bait at the ready in case one swims up to the boat. African Pompano can be found typically near structure and as shallow as 80'. AJ's are around structure as well, they are fun to bend a rod if you are looking for a great fight. There has been a lot of bait at all depths so keep an eye out for Bonito and Spanish Mackerel feeding on the bait, look for surface activity and working birds to locate them, they are lots of fun on light tackle – don't forget the wire leader for the Mackerel! Trolling lures or drifting larger live baits on the outer edges of the Spanish Mackerel schools may find a hungry King too. Last, but not least, Permit are everywhere...look for them on any wrecks / reefs with high relief and around the towers – they are lots of fun to catch and cannot resist a live crab.

Pick a calm day and get out there and have some fun...and be safe.

The Triple Crown Tournament is a fun, challenging, and competitive contest. The goal is to catch a Tarpon of 30 inches or more, and the largest Redfish and Snook over a four month period. It is also very relaxed as it allows the angler to fish at her or his own pace. The angler can fish at any time, day or night, anywhere within the backwater boundaries established by Marco Sportfishing Club, and with any other angler (*no professional guides*) or alone. Seven BIG cash awards will be given out at the end of the contest. The winner will also have her/his name engraved on an individual nameplate attached to a perpetual trophy plaque that is displayed

at the Compass Group at Morgan Stanley, the local sponsoring firm.

The registration fee is \$20 if received on or before June 30, 2023

\$25 if received after June 30 until August 31, 2023

No entries will be accepted after August 31, 2023

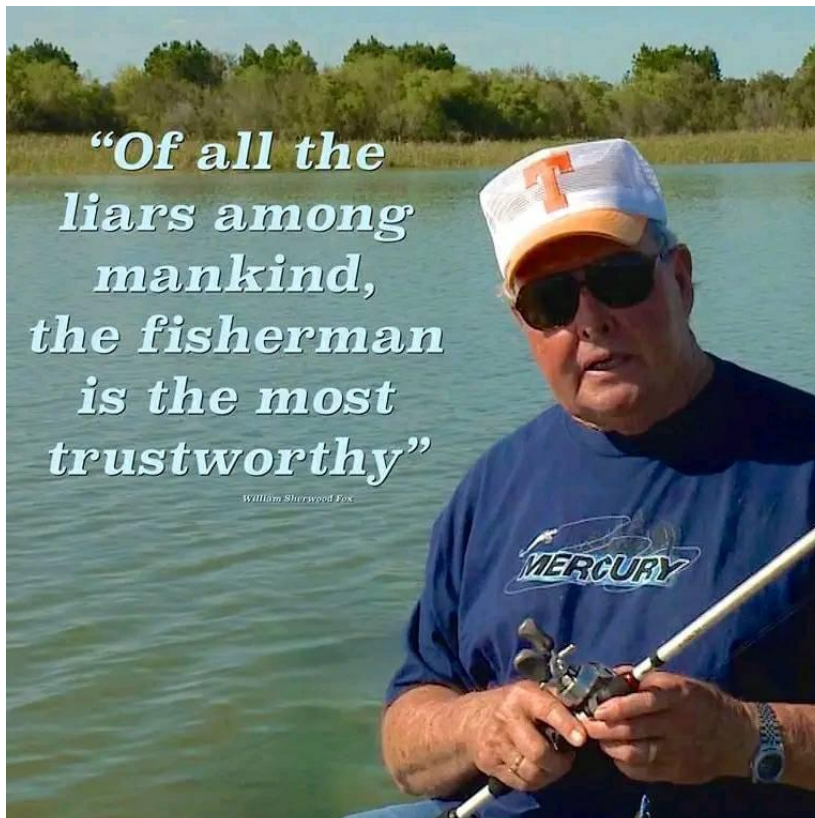

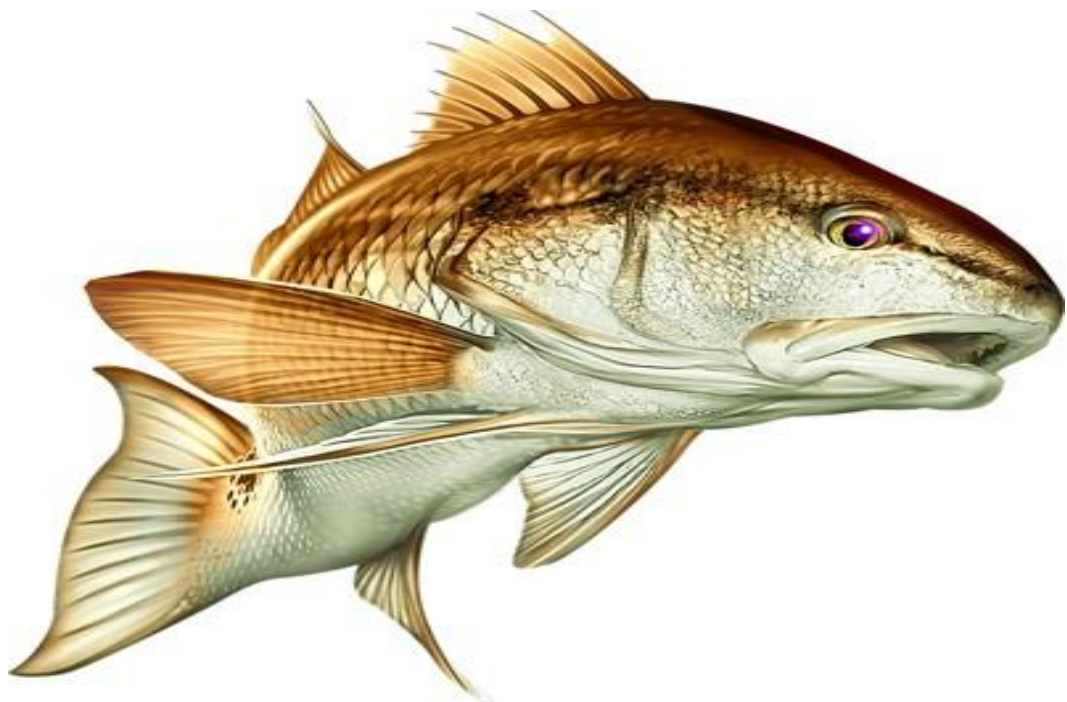

MSC Annual American Patriot Trip – 2023

Once again, members of Marco SportFishing Club ventured out into the very deep blue Gulf of Mexico aboard the American Patriot Long Range Fishing Vessel. From April 24-27, twenty-one MSC anglers and guests enjoyed amazing fishing and dining aboard the 135' vessel based at Marco Island's own Rose Marina.



Early weather predictions of 8' seas brought a little nervousness to all, but like last year, the fishing Gods smiled down on us and we had 4 beautiful and productive days at sea. We left on Monday afternoon with most of last year's anglers having it down pat: Get your bunk prepared, your fishing gear and clothes ready for early the next morning, enjoy the first scrumptious meal of Filet Mignon prepared by Chef Mike,

orientation by Captain Jerry, some satellite TV or socializing, then hit the bunks for the 12 hour, 150 miles due west trip. The first timers fit right in with the program.

Early the next morning, awakened by the smell of coffee, bacon & eggs, everyone arose anxious to eat and start fishing.



Deep drop fishing is unlike what most anglers are accustomed to. Most local offshore anglers stay within 50-60 miles and fish in + or - 110' of water. At 150 miles you enter the "Pulley Ridge" waters, where you are fishing in 700' of water. Three-pound weights and electric reels are the most common means of fishing, however, some ambitious club members did successfully try their hand at "slow pitch jigging" too. The catch was on from the very beginning. Captain Jerry said it was his job to locate the fish "under the boat", but it was our job to put them "on the boat" and we did! He would drift a location, if we hooked up, he would linger a bit, if not he would move on to another of his many spots.

Blueline tile fish, yellow eye, vermillion and queen snapper, and snowy grouper were biting, much to the delight of all. Fish were coming up, mates were tagging the fish and dumping them in the saltwater ice cooler in a flurry of activity. At one point, almost all 21 fishing rods were bent, keeping the mates running. At noon, no one wanted to stop for lunch, but Chef's 12oz



cheeseburgers and fries lured us in. After a quick bite, we waddled back outside to continue the afternoon's fishing... till dinner. Then some of the more ambitious anglers continued fishing at night.

The next day was more of the same, except even better. Most of the returning anglers were searching for Queen snappers and Captain Jerry did not disappoint. Although sporadic the day before, they came to feed this day. Several were contenders for the "pool" (biggest), with Al Jennings taking a close 1st place in the Snapper category with a nice Queen. The father/son team of Keith and Sean Wolthman were high hands with a big cooler of fish, with Paul Strenkert lugging off a cooler full also. John Marchetti took the biggest fish category with a beefy Snowy Grouper.

The crew contributed fish for a sumptuous closing night's dinner. Each dinner began with salad, but always ended with the Chef's

homemade dessert. Key Lime pies ended a perfect day. Oh, did I mention the 24-hour ice cream machine?

Cautiously, I compare this to a cruise, without your spouse (they are missed though), but with your fishing equipment. An absolutely great time was had by all. The biggest question was, "When's the next one?"
