President's Message for August 2023

Offshore Update – August 2023

What's Happening Offshore...

Don't forget...Gag Grouper is closed and will re-open Sept 1 through Nov 10, 2023. Amberjack is closed and will re-open Aug 1, 2023 through Aug 25, 2023. Red Grouper is closed and will re-open Jan 1, 2024.

American Red Snapper summer season for recreational anglers opened June 16 and will close July 31, 2023. Fall season will be every Friday-Sunday in the months of October and November 2023. "For Hire" vessels may harvest from June 1 through August 24, 2023.

Hopefully everyone got their fair share of Red Grouper prior to the closure July 21. American Red Snapper (ARS) can be caught starting at 130', best fishing typically begins at 160'. Reports on American Red Snapper are mixed with some finding fish in known spots and others not finding fish in spots that were known to be productive in the past. Once you find fish, limits come fast. My personal experience so far this season is that some spots that have been very productive in prior years are not holding any fish currently...American Reds or other species (see photo below of a nice ARS recently caught by my nephew). Snapper can be caught at all depths (bigger fish usually being in deeper water) near reefs / wrecks and on ledges. Cobia have shown up recently, not sure if these are migrating fish or residents, but they all taste the same, keep a jig or live bait at the ready in case one swims up to the boat (see photo of a Cobia caught July 18). African Pompano can be found typically near structure and as shallow as 80'. AJ's are around structure as well, they are fun to bend a rod if you are looking for a great fight. There has been a lot of bait at all depths so keep an eye out for Bonito and Spanish Mackerel feeding on the bait, look for surface activity and working birds to locate them, they are lots of fun on light tackle - don't forget the wire leader for the Mackerel! Trolling lures or drifting larger live baits on the outer edges of the Spanish Mackerel schools may find a hungry King too. Permit seem to have disappeared of late, but keep looking for them they should be around through fall...look for them on any wrecks / reefs with high relief and around the towers - they are lots of fun to catch and cannot resist a live crab. If you are really looking for an adventure, and own a gas station, some captains are running out to Pully Ridge and doing very well on many species not common in our local waters (see photo of a double header of Scamp Grouper caught on one slow pitch jig).

Pick a calm day and get out there and have some fun...and be safe.






