President's Message for September 2023



The steamy hot weather is still in full swing here in southwest Florida, it's a little cooler than we saw in August, but not much. Fishing has slowed down a bit, not just from the lack of fish, but from the heat. I think the fish are searching for cooler waters offshore. If you plan to fish, be sure to stay hydrated and wear sunscreen. As Fall weather conditions return to Marco, the fishing should pick up. "Fall" in Marco arrives when the color of license plates changes...

The "No Bait" backwater event on August 15th was a bit of a bust, with few fish caught. One team ran the table and took home all the prizes – check out the report in this edition.

The "Triple Crown Tournament" has reached the halfway point and some very nice sized fish have been reported. The August slowdown has affected this event too. We still only have one person with a slam but six tarpon have been caught. We also have six snook, but only one redfish has been landed. With two more months to go, we hope to see more fish added to the tally sheet. 2024 New Membership Option

**Back for the third year, the “revised”
new member application process.**

In previous years, MSC held open enrollment for new members starting on November 1st. New members joining on, or after that date, could receive up to two months of membership in the current year, in addition to the following year.

Once again for 2023 - the open enrolment date will begin on September 1st!

New members will pay their dues for 2024 and are entitled to membership for the remainder of 2023. That could mean up to 4 months of “free” membership.

Offshore Update – September 2023

What's Happening Offshore...

Don't forget...Gag Grouper will re-open Sept 1 through Nov 10, 2023. Amberjack re-opened Aug 1, 2023 and closed on Aug 25, 2023. Red Grouper is closed and will re-open Jan 1, 2024. American Red Snapper fall season will be every Friday-Sunday in the months of October and November 2023.

Red Snapper summer season is closed, red grouper is closed, amberjack opened and closed 3.5 weeks later...the good news is that Gag Grouper season is opening Sept 1. Gags have been a bit more plentiful the last year or so, you can target them around any reef structure any ledges nearshore or offshore (I would avoid hard / live bottom offshore given the Red Grouper closure and the potential to harm these fish during their closed season). Snapper can be caught at all depths (bigger fish usually being in deeper water) near reefs / wrecks and on ledges. Cobia have shown up recently, not sure if these are migrating fish or residents, but they all taste the same, keep a jig or live bait at the ready in case one swims up to the boat. African Pompano can be found typically near structure and as shallow as 80'. AJ's are around structure as well, they are fun to bend a rod if you are looking for a great fight. There has been a lot of bait at all depths so keep an eye out for Bonito and Spanish Mackerel feeding on the bait, look for surface activity and working birds to locate them, they are lots of fun on light tackle – don't forget the wire leader for the Mackerel! Trolling lures or drifting larger live baits on the outer edges of the Spanish Mackerel schools may find a hungry King too. Permit have returned of late and they should be around through fall...look for them on any wrecks / reefs with high relief and around the towers – they are lots of fun to catch and cannot resist a live crab.

Pick a calm day and get out there and have some fun...and be safe.

Fishing Apps Reviewed in the August Club Meeting

Google Earth (Satellite Images)

High definition satellite images for identifying and mapping fishing locations. Use this app to get GPS coordinates to use as waypoints when creating tracks or routes, get GPS coordinates of your current location, view where the shallow water is, become familiar with the area you will be fishing, along with a number of other useful functions.

Tide Charts by 7th Gear (Tides)

Tide data for all locations / times. Use this app to determine what the tides are going to be at different locations on any given day. The app allows you to search days, weeks or months in advance so you can pick the best days and times to go out. Use this app correctly and you'll never find yourself stuck on your lift because the tide is too low!

Ventusky, Windy (Weather)

Detailed global weather map with forecasts based on multiple selectable models or blended. Forecasts for wind, waves, temperature / humidity, cloud cover, storm activity to name a few.

Marine Weather (Weather)

NOAA Buoy weather conditions and forecasts. Select a buoy to view, current wind and / or wave height data & forecasts available depending upon buoy selected.

Clime (Weather Radar)

Detailed global weather radar real time and forecasted conditions. Use this app to see storm activity real time on and off the water and plan for safety.

Fish Rules (Season / Limits)

Species by species details for open / closed seasons and size / bag limits in state and federal waters, a must have.

Discussed but not presented:

Map My Walk (Tracking)

Use to track your journey and maintain a trail to know how far you have traveled and have a map back to your starting point in case you get lost / disoriented in the backwater. Works based on GPS and does not require cell coverage.

Fish Weather (Weather)

Similar to Ventusky and Windy.

The Triple Crown Tournament is underway! This event began on July 1st and will run until October 31st. Targeted fish are snook, redfish & tarpon. Best of all, there's still time to get in on the action - **but you've got to act quickly**. As of THIS writing (*yes, there have been several revisions the last few days*) Ken Robertson sits on top of the leaderboard with John Marchetti in second place - due to their trifecta catch of all the targeted species. Pre-dawn and early morning starts seem to be the right strategy these days with the "catch window" being as short as an hour or two before the heat of the day sends the fish into hibernation.

There were 3 boats that braved the heat and one only 1 kayak that dared fish the elements. Two boats reported no fish.

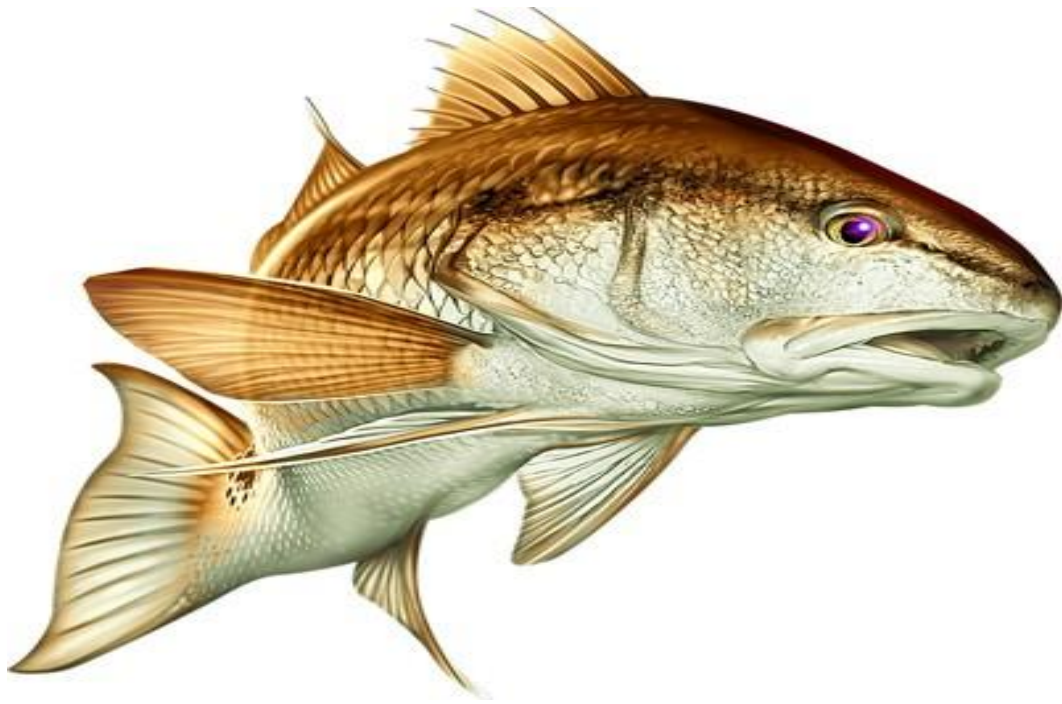
