President's Message for October 2023



I want to take this opportunity to mention the passing of Peter Arcidiacono, (*a.k.a.* "*Pete A*" or "*Capt. Pete*"), on September 12th. Whatever name you used for Pete, he always responded to you with a smile. Pete joined the club in early 2002, and for 21 years he was the heart and soul of our organization. No one had more enthusiasm for our club events or worked harder to see that every member felt welcome. Many of the events were created by Pete, but all were actively championed by him. He always encouraged members to participate whether it was a fishing event, social gathering,

or his favorite, "fish tales". In fact, in recognition for his love of fishing in the annual "2-Man Redfish" event, we changed the name to the "Capt. Pete 2-Man Redfish Tournament". Pete dedicated all his free time to helping the club grow and prosper. He was our president multiple times, serving more than 10 years at the helm. Even when not the president, he was continuously an active participant on the Board of Directors. Pete will be missed by all. Rest in Peace, my friend.

In October the weather is typically warm and sunny, with average temperatures ranging from the low 70s to the high 80s. However, it is important to be aware that we are in the height of hurricane season, so keep an eye on the long-range forecasts, and have a plan to keep your family, home, and boat safe. October usually brings the larger redfish in from offshore waters, and we have plenty of events to take advantage of the schools of big redfish this month. So, get out there and catch them!

September Events

- The "Snook and a Red" backwater event was a success, with anglers catching several nice snook and a few redfish. However, redfish were still hard to find, so be patient and keep trying. We know they are out there.
- The "Triple Crown Tournament" completed its third month, and anglers have reported a total of 8 tarpon, 8 snook, and 6 redfish... thus far.
- The "Offshore Slam" completed its ninth month, and anglers have recorded a total of 9 slams so far. There are still 3 months left in the tournament. There's plenty of time to get in on the action.



- The "Pork Cook-off Picnic", held on September 6th, was a winner! Attendees enjoyed delicious pulled pork prepared by our member "Chefs", and one skilled contestant was selected by our celebrity judges as "Chef of the Year". As tough as the fishing was in the Snook and a Red, the pork was so tender!!!
- Howard Laskau hosted the September kayak event on Sept 14 at Port of the Isles. This was a great opportunity to explore the area from a "close to the water" perspective, and challenged the anglers who were fishing the mangroves. In October we look forward to the following events.
- "Capt. Pete's 2-Man Redfish Tournament" will be held on October 11th. This is a competition for cash prizes, but mostly for "bragging rights". The tournament begins at 8:00 AM with a "Shotgun Start" from both the Jolley Bridge and Walker's Coon Key Marina.
- "Redfish XVIII Team Event and Picnic" is a fun event for the whole family. This will be a team tournament, "red team vs blue team". The event will be held the week of October 23rd and culminates with a picnic in Sarazen Park on October 27th. Look for a "**special**" change to this event in the Redfish XVIII flyer.
- "Triple Crown Tournament" and "Offshore Slam" will continue throughout the month of October; however, the "Triple Crown Tournament" wraps up at the end of the month.
- A Kayak Event is scheduled for October 17th at Shell Island/Rookery Bay. This event is open to all skill levels and is a great way to explore the beautiful backwaters near Port of the Islands. Contact Howard Laskau if you want to join in the fun.

Don't forget we have the monthly "Fish of the Month (FOM)" contest, and you can enter your catch for the leaderboard. October's FOM is Redfish, naturally.

Offshore Update – October 2023

What's Happening Offshore...

Don't forget...Gag Grouper is open through Nov 10, 2023. Red Grouper is closed and will re-open Jan 1, 2024. American Red Snapper fall season will be every Friday-Sunday in the months of September, October and November 2023.

Red Snapper fall season has started again. Gag Grouper is open and they have been a bit more plentiful the last year or so, you can target them around reef / wreck structure and ledges nearshore or offshore (I would avoid hard / live bottom offshore given the Red Grouper closure and the potential to harm these fish during their closed season). Snapper can be caught at all depths (bigger fish usually being in deeper water) near reefs / wrecks and on ledges. There have been some pretty large snapper caught recently. Cobia are around again as well, keep a jig or live bait at the ready in case one swims up to the boat. African Pompano can be found typically near structure and as shallow as 80'. AJ's are around structure as well, they are fun to bend a rod if you are looking for a great fight. There has been a lot of bait at all depths so keep an eye out for Bonito and Spanish Mackerel feeding on the bait, look for surface activity and working birds to locate them, they are lots of fun on light tackle – don't forget the wire leader for the Mackerel! Trolling lures or drifting larger live baits on the outer edges of the Spanish Mackerel schools may find a hungry King too. Permit have been hit or miss of late, but they should be around through fall...look for them on wrecks / reefs with high relief and around the towers – they are lots of fun to catch and cannot resist a live crab.

Fall is coming, the water temps should start to drop soon. This will bring more Cobia and Mackerel into the area.

Pick a calm day and get out there and have some fun...and be safe.

Redfish Release – Isle of Capri

On September 7, 2023 two trucks pulled up at the Isle of Capri paddle park. Attending the event and taking pictures were Jay Jones and John Ryckman from the club. Both trucks were pulling large dual axle trailers. Each trailer contained 5,000 juvenile redfish measuring 3-4 inches that were soon to be swimming free. The Costal Conservation Association (CCA) Florida. the Duke Energy Mariculture Center and the FWC partnered together for the fish release.


The Duke Energy Mariculture Center is located over 260 miles north of the Paddle Park. When the trailer rolled up at 1pm, they had been in the tanks for 5 hours. The trip was not without problems. Both trailers blew tires on the way down. But when released I did not see and dead fish floating around so the did manage to survive the early September southwest Florida heat.

I know the club would like to see more fish releases down hear and see some south of Marco in the 10,000 islands. In speaking with one of the CCA members, he said that this was as far south as they could go without starting to see some fish loss.

According to the Duke Energy Mariculture Center website, they release more the 100,000 fish, shrimp and crabs into the gulf every year. The site has eight one-acre ponds that hold 1,000,000 gallons of seawater each. They currently target 12 marine species for cultivation.

What we need to run a Picnic

This is a short list of positions we need to fill to hold successful club picnics. In an average year, Dave would hold six picnics (January – June). Other events also hold picnics, and this list can work for those events as well.

One thing we are planning this year, to reduce the workload and number of people required to run a picnic, is to make the picnics "bring your own beverage", beer or wine. We are evaluating whether we will continue to supply water and soft drinks, but that decision will likely be determined by the volunteers we have for events.

There are detailed activities beyond what I have listed here if you are thinking about offering your services in any of these roles. You can volunteer for a single event, if you are here seasonally, or to become the person doing an assignment for all 6 of these picnics. If you have helped Dave and Susie and want to continue to help – let me know.

While we would like to have someone step up to be the lead for all 6 picnics, we realize that we could do them with a different lead person each month... If you wanted to lead, say the March picnic, that might be fine.

- 1. Picnic Leader plan and coordinate picnic activities
- 2. Beverages purchase beverages and ice and stock coolers
- 3. Trash work as a team to handle the trash at picnics.
- 4. Check-in picnic roster, 50/50 and club waivers leads + assistants
- 5. Servers depending on the menu the number required will vary.

As you look at this list – just think back to one of Dave's picnics and you will recall the people who helped make those events memorable. Also realize that some did more than a single task. Some tasks are rather minor, and some more time consuming – but all are necessary.


