Offshore Update - January 2024

What's Happening Offshore...

Red Grouper re-opens January 1, 2024. Get them while you can...

Red Grouper should be out there on live / hard bottom, with the larger fish in the deeper water (100'+). The Red Grouper should be hungry, they haven't seen an 8oz lead weight or jig in months. Snapper can be caught at all depths (bigger fish usually being in deeper water) near reefs / wrecks / towers and on ledges / live bottom. You can drift for them, but best method (in my opinion) is to locate them and anchor / chum. Depending upon water temperature (they like mid to upper 70's), Kingfish will be around structure and can be a by-catch while Snapper fishing, if you get bit off in the chum slick put out a Kingfish rig with wire and see what happens. The cooler water temperatures brought the Cobia into the area in numbers prior to the December winds and they may still be out there if the waters settle down sometime this century, keep a jig or live bait at the ready in case a Cobia swims up to the boat. African Pompano can be found typically near structure and as shallow as 80'. AJ's are around structure as well, they are fun to bend a rod if you are looking for a great fight. Keep an eye out for Bonito and Spanish Mackerel feeding on the bait schools, look for surface activity and working birds to locate them, they are lots of fun on light tackle – don't forget the wire leader for the Mackerel! Trolling lures or drifting larger live baits on the outer edges of the Spanish Mackerel schools may find a hungry King too. Permit will start to migrate back to the higher elevation reefs and towers in late spring when the water temperatures rise.

Pick a calm day and get out there and have some fun...and be safe.

Entry Fee: \$25 for MSC Anglers (must be an active MSC member to enter)

Changes from the 2023 Offshore Slam:

No changes.

Prizes: Based on number of anglers participating, maximum one prize per angler

- Total combined length of the largest fish of each Offshore Slam species entered by the angler. If an angler catches more than 2 of the included species the 2 with the longest length will be counted.
- All fish entered must be caught by the angler entering the fish without assistance.
- Angler may upgrade any fish entered if a larger specimen is caught within the tournament timeframe.
- This is an individual angler tournament and is not tied to a specific captain or boat. The angler may fish on anyone's boat at any time see "No Guide Rule" below (like the Triple Crown).
- In addition to the Offshore Slam prizes, the largest fish of each individual species will be awarded a prize, as will the boat captain with the most entries caught.
- Any fish caught during this event will also qualify for MSC Leaderboard and Fish of the Month entry.

Rules:

- 1. All anglers must be an active MSC Member.
- 2. MSC "No Guide Rule" applies No fishing with, or on, a guide's boat.
- 3. MSC "Offshore Boundaries" apply South to Lat N 25.10.0, North to Lat N 26.05.5120', must fish within these boundaries and at a depth of 120' or less.
- 4. "Two Line Rule" applies No more than two rods per angler.
- 5. All fish entered must be caught by the angler entering the fish without assistance from any other angler with the exception of landing (gaff, net, etc).
- 6. Each fish entered must be photographed individually on a vertical edge tournament ruler, mouth closed and tight against the vertical edge of the ruler (not following the measurement rules may result in a reduction in size if the measurement is not clearly evident). All entry photos must be emailed to Jim Scarpa at the email address above within 24 hours of being caught, please include the name of the boat captain as well.
- 7. Sign-up Sheet and Entry Fee must be received by Jim Scarpa by June 30, 2024 or the angler cannot participate in the tournament. While tournament entry is allowed after fishing begins, no fish may be entered in the tournament that is caught prior to the angler submitting their Sign-up Sheet and Entry Fee.
- 8. All participants must have a signed waiver on file or provided with your sign-up sheet to participate.


If the weather is poor and we do not fish, the party goes on no matter what.



Non-Member Angler* plus picnic \$40.00 Waiver Required


